Nashville Conductors going 'Under the Big Top'

The Conductors, Nashville's local levi, leather, and fetish club, will host its 34th annual leather run the weekend of March 4–6, 2016. The theme of this year's run weekend, Track XXXIV, is "Under a Big Top." Nashville will play host to leather men and women from all over the United States for a fun-filled weekend of leather, fun and brotherhood.

The Conductors—a member club of the Mid-America Conference of Clubs—is also one of Nashville's longest-



surviving social service organizations. Originally founded in 1982 by a core group of friends who shared an appreciation for leather, the group has built fellowship within the local leather community, while building goodwill in the wider LGBT community by giving back.

The emergence of the AIDS crisis in Nashville shortly after the group's formation, and the formation of Nashville CARES soon after, led The Conductors to focus fundraising efforts on offering financial assistance to clients of CARES.

The Conductors fund an emergency assistance program through CARES that assists clients with severe and emergent need who have exhausted all other sources of financial support. The Conductors program is anonymous. Member Jackie Walton is proud of the fact that "we support Nashville CARES and in 33 years we've never turned anyone down." The group has funded prescriptions, co-pays, eyeglasses, utility bills, home repair, rent, among many other need items for those in dire need.

But the social element has always been at the centre of The Conductors' mission as well, and a big part of that is the annual run. From The Conductors' website: "Since our founding in 1982 we have celebrated our anniversary every year, primarily in March, with our club's 'Run.' This is a chance for us to invite our leather brothers and sisters to Nashville for a weekend of fun and fellowship...."


The "Under a Big Top" weekend begins with registration at 3 p.m. on Friday, March 4, and the cocktail parties start at 5 p.m. (10–15 official cocktail parties are planned over the weekend). All food and drinks are included in the price of the run (except during bar crawls). Transportation will be provided for any events outside the host hotel. Final Farewells will be held Sunday, March 6, starting at 2 p.m. at the Stirrup, which is the club's "home bar."

A few of the events to look forward to during this year's run include:

- Official events, like the Mid-America Conference of Clubs Fall meeting for all member clubs, the formal dinner with clubs in uniforms and colours, and awards, along with cocktail parties hosted by clubs, bars and members
- The Conductors Run show—a show unlike any other, featuring Conductors club brothers and associates in ways you always (or never!) wanted to see
- "Freak and Fetish," an annual event hosted by the Sisters of Perpetual Indulgence at Trax
- Bar Crawls—Stirrup, Trax, Tribe, Play, Canvas, Blue Genes, and Vibe
- After Hours with demonstrations/teaching and playroom time
- Mr. Friendly

Meet the member... Giorgio!







We're into 'year two' of our "meet the member series" and we've still got more to go! This month, meet Giorgio, our Brazilian Adonis from Queens.

Giorgio became a full member of Empire City MC in January 2013, prior to that, he had been a solo rider since 2007. Although he had known of ECMC's existence (thanks to our webpage), he felt coming to a meeting was somewhat awkward as he didn't know any of the members, especially after seeing all the photos of members embracing each other like life-long friends. One fateful day while he was shopping at New York Harley-

Davidson, he ran across one of our members, Eddie. Eddie introduced Giorgio to the club, Giorgio felt that it seemed like a fun thing to do and the rest was history!

Giorgio came to the United States from Brazil where he had been riding since he was 13 years old. His first bike was a 50cc Honda, but he quickly went though many more – 75cc, 100cc, then a Yamaha 250cc and up to a Honda CB 550. When he came to the States, he rode a 1200cc H-D Sportster for a couple years then upgraded to a 2009 H-D Rocker C, a 1600cc beast of a bike (with lots of lighting effects!) Giorgio's dream bike is a robust H-D Road King-Style Trike (3-wheeler).

Of all the ECMC rides and events to date, the trip to Ocean City Bike Week has been his favourite – with the ferry ride over to Cape May and the constant rumbling of thunder from all the bikes there. Giorgio's dream is to ride the "Trail of the Mountain Spirits", a ride

through the deserts and mountains of the mid-west United States.







Giorgio is married, but his husband, Ed, is not a rider and isn't interested in riding; however, Ed's completely comfortable with Giorgio riding and going out of town on some weekends, provided Giorgio stocks the fridge and pantry before he leaves, jokes Giorgio. He says he's been very lucky to have a naturally-occurring work/life/riding balance and there's almost never any conflict.

A few years ago, Giorgio became a vegan (for those of you who aren't 'in the know', vegans are the next level up from vegetarians and do not consume any animal nor animal byproducts. I provided the description, as some of Giorgio's friends thought "vegan" was the

same as "straight" or "not gay anymore!") This was a life choice he made for himself and isn't one to impose his lifestyle upon others. You can see in some of the photos here that he has lost significant weight and looks much happier; however, he reports that the conversion to being vegan wasn't easy and required that he hire a coach to help him. Bikers tend to eat at a lot of rubbish places, many whom don't know what is and is not vegan-friendly, so Giorgio has learnt to pack some food of his own and carry on. Educating people what a vegan is and is not seems to be the only preaching he does, and I'm sure that's because he does not want to be thought of as "straight!" ©

In addition to motor-biking, Giorgio also enjoys BICYCLING ultra-light speed bikes. As you can imagine, with only two days off a week, there's a bit of contention as to if he will ride the bike or the motorcycle – as there are no folding versions of speed bikes, they are mutually-exclusive pastimes! Giorgio had a very happy home-life with his husband Ed who enjoys astronomy and reading. (And yes, if you're wondering, Giorgio convinced Ed to become Vegan as well!)
