

Meet the member - Earl D

When Earl was only 14 years old he got his first ride on the back of a bike – the "bike bug" bit, as only five years later he walked into a motorcycle shop in Philadelphia, money and learner's permit in hand and bought a Honda CB360... provided the salesman "show him how to ride it"! A little while after the transaction was complete, Earl and the salesman went to a dead-end side-street next to the dealer and they spent 10 minutes learning how to ride! Following that 10 minute lesson, he was riding it home! Of course, this was long before there were any motorcycle safety courses or the Motorcycle Safety Foundation. He rode that bike all. Over from exotic places such as Missouri and Virginia to Massachusetts – it was also his primary transportation to school and work.

Earl sold his CB360 after about 2 years as his life went in a different direction and for the next 20 years, he had no driving licence and went into recovery after this time lapsed. As a reward for himself after becoming sober, he arranged financing for a new motorcycle and requested permission to apply for a new driving licence. He was granted permission by complete coincidence on his birthday that year and bought a VTX1300 and was involved with a VTX riding group which rode to several destinations and made the Guinness Book of World Records for the largest gathering of VTX motorcycles in one place. This was his first time riding with others. Shortly thereafter, he upgraded to a Suzuki Boulevard.




Earl searched for a gay riding club in Philadelphia, researching the "MCs" but found only about two actual motorcycles in the two clubs he found at the time. The clubs he discovered weren't riding clubs at all, even though they had back-patches like real MCs. In addition, as a sober rider, he didn't want to be associated with any club that revolved around taverns and bars.

Earl became involved with the New Jersey Eagles for about 2-3 years, and although they were a riding club, they were more of a social riding club, not a real MC. He had spotted some of the events that Empire City MC had posted on their facebook group and yahoo group about events and decided to check out the "Biker Weekend" ride to "The Ranch" in Hemlock, NY. He had a great time at the event, and it's now his favourite annual motorcycle event! The second year he came to ECMC's Biker Weekend, Earl got two ECMC members to sponsor his application for Associate Membership and he was accepted as an Associate Member July 2014. After completing one year of Full Member-level participation and attendance, he applied for Full Membership and was accepted as a Full Member in July 2015.


His favourite ride to date has been the trip to Deal's Gap and the Tail of the Dragon, ECMC's 50th Anniversary, week-long motorcycle trip. Even though he had a broken coccyx throughout the entire trip.

Earl upgraded to a fully-loaded Honda Gold Wing in May 2015, as it's more comfortable for touring, but he claims he has no problems riding it in the city, as Philadelphia has motorcycle-only corral parking throughout centre city for \$5/24 hours or \$250/unlimited for 12 months.

His dream ride is a cross-country tour lasting $1\frac{1}{2}$ -2 months so he can really explore. Although riding as a group is fun, solo riding allows one to stop wherever and whenever





He still can't believe how we went from being homeless and making no income for nearly 20 years to owning a condo, a motorcycle and a car holding three college degrees and working towards his doctorate.
