#### DAVID DAY OF SPARTANS MC AND DELTA BROTHERHOOD IN NEAR-FATAL COLLISION

David Day, a member of the Delta Brotherhood and ECMC's brother club Spartans MC was in a near-fatal automobile collision. It happened on the evening of 3<sup>rd</sup> December in the northern Virginia suburbs of Washington, DC. David is known as nnflyboy on Recon and is shown in the back row, third from the left.

According to sources, David has multiple broken bones and one amputation. He lost his left arm and suffered either a break, sprain or strain nearly everywhere else. No head injuries, nor internal organ damage was reported. He is at Inova Fairfax Hospital in Falls Church, VA and visitation was strictly limited at the time of this writing. Flowers and other items are <u>not</u> allowed in the ICU. He has requested that the Hospital not give out info at this time. Get-well cards can be sent to David Day in care of the Fire Company:

Volunteer Firefighter Expected To Survive After VA I-234 Crash



An off-duty volunteer firefighter critically injured in a crash with a tractor-trailer Saturday night on VA I-234 is expected to survive, police say.

The wreck happened about 5:47 p.m. near the intersection of Bristow Road when, witnesses said, a sedan slammed into the back of a tractor-trailer.

Rescue crews worked for hours to free the driver from the wreckage. He was flown by helicopter to a trauma center with serious injuries, but Prince William spokesman Nathan Probus on Monday said he is expected to survive.

VA I-234 headed toward Dumfries was closed at Independent Hill Drive until about 9PM. Police and fire officials confirmed the driver is a volunteer firefighter, but did not release his name or fire department affiliation. He was not on duty at the time.
