The entire town of Gimli takes on an unmistakably Icelandic hue during Islendingadagurinn, the annual Icelandic cultural festival. World-famous strongmen compete, and local delicacies like vínarterta (prune cake) and Brennivín (Icelandic aquavit) are plentiful. But even on a regular day in Gimli, you'll hear Icelandic being spoken and see traditional Icelandic clothing being worn.
