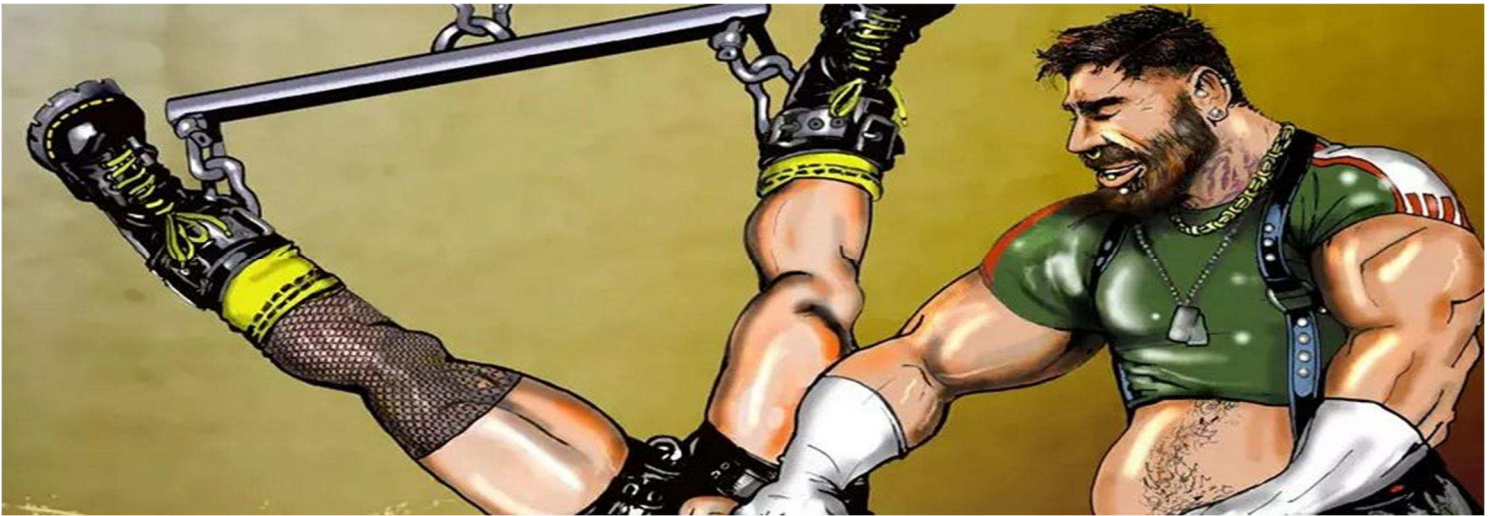

Make sure to check their daily agenda, because events and dresscode - often mandatory - change each day. If you are in Berlin and looking for a night

Let's just say with about 40 slings, an intricate watersports area, and so many dark corners to find fun in – you can't go wrong. Warning: some nights at this venue are "scat nights", and although they clean the place out so very well, you wouldn't know it! However, if you're not into this activity or are sensitive to smells, you want to avoid it on those nights – always check their website first before going. Friday nights before Easter weekend tend to be nude or fetish wear only. When I say fetish wear I mean minimalistic fetish wear like a harness A jockstrap wristbands etc not an entire outfit. Some of the official events I went to included:

Friday evening, before going to Lab.Oratory, there was a “Leather Dinner” which was quite nice the photos at the top of this article of just one of the five rooms full of Leatherman. On Saturday, the leather boat cruise took place (which as soon as the DJ turned his amplifier on I abandoned the boat and sold my ticket, as did a few other people!), this was not a tourist exploration boat cruise by any means it was a loud dance party and had no place in public view. On Sunday night, my farewell event this year, was **The official Easter PiG Party** – a “Men only” fetish Easter party starting at 22:00, the end is open (excuse the pun!) PiG Party uses the location in the Connection CLUB, in the middle of Berlin. There's also a great DJ line-up, and of course lots of hot guys with whom you'll have fun! A MUST for everyone who is in Berlin at Easter and wants fun! This is a remarkable location which is suitable for dancing in the dance area where the music was, and cruising which had the music at a much lower level for ambient background sound and tempo for the activities going on around in the place! From the fuck room to the glory hole rooms to the video booths, even a couple of slings are set up for your enjoyment! I highly recommend this event and I strongly advise that you get to it early (21:30) and line up you'll thank me.

Enough about 2024 let's talk about 2025 for a minute. Easter will be on the 20th of April in 2025. This means because of the late Easter the weather will be more accommodating, and because of the date “4/20” combined with the fact that on Easter Monday this year Germany passed a law legalising marijuana sale and usage, I guarantee that there will be a lot of partying going on everywhere. If the scent of marijuana bothers you, you might not want to go. Remember in Germany there's still a lot of indoor smoking and the tobacco scent alone can be revolting to some, combine that with the scent of marijuana and it might be game over. They are a small hotel the rooms will be gone rapidly if not already.



Empire City's Motorcycle Weekend + Spring Week-Long Ride



Attached to this newsletter is the run application for our annual motorcycle weekend. This year the run application and the actual ride itself has dramatically changed because of our 60th anniversary. Following the motorcycle weekend we will be spending a week in Ohio tooling around and checking out sites causing all sorts of chaos in our wake. At the completion of Ohio we'll pop back into the Pittsburgh area spend the night and then ride our motorcycles in the Pittsburgh pride parade on the 1st of June – immediately following the parade we will return to our hosts and load up our bikes and ride to Paris burg to spend the night there at our halfway point hotel. On Sunday we will return to New York City, allowing people on this leg of our journey to split off in their own direction as needed.

We understand that not everybody can take 11 days off to do a trip like this, not to mention this is just the first of two weeklong journeys to celebrate empire city's 60th anniversary. We've set up this trip so you can inject yourself and remove yourself from various portions of it. It might look a little bit complex to you, but this will make it as flexible as we possibly can for people with different needs.

Of course, this is a motorcycle only event. We may have a support vehicle trailing us to help with luggage. To be honest we're still hammering out the final details right now but our application is attached to this newsletter and as soon as we know how many people are going, will be better suited to accommodate everyone as best we can.

No more Speeding – ever?

Representatives from the MRF attended a roundtable discussion held by the Road to Zero Coalition on this initiative and were troubled by many aspects of this proposal.

It is important to note that this is not about speed governors. This proposal is about a dynamic system using vehicle cameras, road signs, GPS, and virtual maps to determine speed limits on roads and actively restrict vehicles from operating above a certain threshold.

ABATE of California, the California Motorcycle Dealers Association, the California Trucking Association, the California Manufacturers and Technology Association and the Specialty Equipment Market Association are among the organizations that have gone on record opposing the bill. The MRF remains committed to protecting our freedoms from government overreach. Allowing technology to override driver control of vehicle speed is a slippery slope. We thank the advocates in California for pushing back against this proposal. The MRF will remain vigilant in Washington, D.C., ready to oppose any similarly proposed federal plans.

As always, Ride Safe and Ride Free Perhaps this will backfire when “new bikes” with speed controls simply rot at dealerships, while we refurbish and resell used motorcycles which do not have this lovely technology.



Right to Repair

The Right to Repair affects all of us whether we work on our own bikes or have a shop work on them. The information and tools necessary to make repairs must be available to independent dealers and individuals. Not everyone who owns a newer motorcycle (under ten years old), wants to go to a franchise dealer (regardless of the brand), to get their bike serviced or repaired. We should not be penalized with the threat of losing our warranty for taking our bikes to our favourite independent dealer, whom we have trusted and supported for years. Furthermore, if your bike is over ten years old, most franchise dealers will not even work on that bike.



Most bikers I've met enjoy working on their bikes as much as riding them. It is part of our culture to hang out with our buddies and help each other. Most franchise dealers would prefer to eliminate independent dealers and then charge us outrageous prices for parts and labour. Franchise dealers and manufacturers work hard to restrict parts and updated information from the Independent Motorcycle Aftermarket. Even worse than the high prices is the ridiculous amount of time they want to tie your bike up for service in the middle of riding season. The existence of independent dealers is essential for the survival of our culture, riding lifestyle and the future of motorcycling.

Harley stopped the production of carburetted bikes in 2007 and will not work on your carburetted bike because it is over ten years old. Few have the technicians on staff with experience to work on older bikes. If you own a 2007 – 2013 Harley, where do you go for an electronic fuel injection tune? Harley no longer supplies programable ECUs for these bikes and the EPA has restricted the Aftermarket from selling the current generation of modules to street bike owners. There is even a campaign to penalize any dealer willing to tune your fuel-injected bike. All this is supposedly to help create a clean climate. However, the EPA will not even publish emission standards/limits that are acceptable for the Independent Motorcycle Aftermarket so that it can manufacture the components that will be environmentally compliant. It may seem like motorcycle manufacturers would like to sell you a new bike, service it twice a year and sell you another new bike in five years, but End-of-Life Directives for motorcycles are another issue for discussion at another time.

The MRF has been fighting for our Right to Repair and has pledged its full support to the Independent Motorcycle Aftermarket to continue this battle. We cannot do it alone. We need your support by joining the IMA today so that we may continue fighting this attack on our rights and lifestyle. I will address our Right to Modify and build custom bikes in your next issue of the American Biker Journal.

Come join the fun!

Please read this entire run application carefully as 2024 is vastly different!

You can choose which segments on this 11-day trip that you would ride with us or not! With the exception of Friday 24th-26th when we stay at "The Farm" in Coal Centre, accommodations at hotels will be your responsibility to pay for. Please check the tick-boxes "" to indicate you will be riding with us on that day.

Of course, you are always responsible for your own travel costs, including fuel, tolls, etc. We might have a support vehicle following us through the Ohio segments to lighten our loads; however, this is not yet confirmed, so please do not count on one being there. We ask that you have an EZ-Pass toll transponder on your bike.

Empire City MC seeks, as always, to make this a ZERO-PROFIT event. We only facilitate these events.
