Secrets of the Hells Angels


T.V. Time! It's cold and time to hibernate with some television shows in-between the nice riding days of this (supposedly) mild winter.

Founded in 1948, the <u>Hells Angels</u> Motorcycle Club is an international organization known for its members' preference for riding <u>Harley-Davidson</u> motorcycles.

This docuseries delves into the dark history of the organization, featuring exclusive interviews with five former chapter presidents, law enforcement, and undercover agents.

The Hells Angels proved to be a far more ruthless and cunning organization than expected and this series is sure to keep you on your toes!



Worthy Organisations

As we approach an incoming tyrannical government, protecting others from hate is important – especially when those being targeted are children. Each month until Trump is out of office, we shall focus upon a socially rewarding group that fights back in the face of tyranny.

The **PARASOL PATROL** is one of these groups.

The Parasol Patrol shields children and young people at LGBTQIA+ and BIPOC events. They use rainbow umbrellas to create a visual barrier so kids won't have to see the signs and



angry faces and we even have noise cancelling headphones for the little ones because grown adults come with bullhorns to yell at children.

Activate Stealth Mode - Protect Yourself!

The walls have ears, as does nearly all social media! Be careful what you say online. With A.I. stepping up to the plate and Elon Musk behind the helm with Trump, we're going to see a massive ramp-up in attacks on people for standing up for their rights! I can see a time when American citizens, branded as "dissenters", might even be put into camps and/or deported!

IN PUBLIC: If you plan to attend any rallies/protests, leave your primary phone at home – only use a 'burner' phone when going places or doing things you do not want the government to know about. Cover your face in public to avoid facial recognition from the millions of public cameras. Wear shoes that are uncomfortable to mask your gate (the way you walk). Remove any bluetooth tire-pressure gages from your vehicle, the government is now tracking your movements with them!

ONLINE: Use a VPN (virtual private network) to block your IP address. Do NOT use your real name, address or other identifying information in your anti-establishment/anti-Trump posts. Communicate with others over safe, known encrypted channels. Note: Telegram is NOT encrypted, and What's App metadata will rat



you out! Use SIGNAL for chat/voice/data/video. You can chat with other gay bikers on our private 'Motorcyclists on Signal' group: https://bit.ly/motonsig -- but consider creating a false persona account to protect yourself, as virtually anyone can join this group.

EDUCATE YOURSELF: There are many ways to learn about privacy and protecting yourself and your data. Some of the best ones are "makerspaces". A makerspace is a collaborative workspace inside a school, library or separate public/private facility for making, learning, exploring and sharing that uses high tech to no tech tools. These spaces are open to kids, adults, and entrepreneurs and have a variety of maker equipment including 3D printers, laser cutters, CNC machines, soldering irons and even sewing machines. A makerspace however doesn't need to include all of these machines or even any of them to be considered a makerspace.

In New York City, there are three well-known makerspaces where you can learn all sorts of useful things:

NYC Resistor, 87 3rd Avenue, Fl 4, Brooklyn, NY 11217

There are also many meetings in person and online, such as the <u>2600 Meetings</u> (meeting on the 1st Friday of the month)

Arm yourself with privacy tools and education – the best things we have to hobble and defeat the incoming nazi regime!

We can get through this – but all of us need to work together to defeat the evil coming our way!
