

MINUTES OF THE 104TH AMCC MEETING

I. CALL TO ORDER: The 104th meeting of the Atlantic Motorcycle Coordinating Council was called to order at 1:10 P.M. by President Jose Reyes, at the Holiday Inn, Wilmington DE on September 19, 1992.

IIA. PRESENT: Bucks MC, Centaur MC, C.O.M.M.A.N.D. MC, Crucible MC, Empire City MC, Entre Nous, Excelsior MC, Griffins MC, Hartford Colts MC, Highwaymen TNT, Iron Guard BC, Lost Angels, Pennsmen Inc, Philadelphians MC, Pittsburgh MC, Pocono Warriors, Reading Railmen, Shipmates Club, Spartan MC, Thunderbolts MC, Vanguard MC and Vikings MC.

IIB. PROXY: Cycle MC, MC Faucon, SNC London and Wheels MC.

IIC. ABSENT: Scorpions MC.

III. GUESTS: Henry D. (BC Bears), Alan P. (Philducks) and James L. (Exiles MC).

IV. The minutes of the 103rd meeting were corrected to include C.O.M.M.A.N.D. MC in Section IIA. After the correction was submitted, on a motion by Pittsburgh MC (second Centaur MC), the minutes were accepted as corrected.

V. OFFICER REPORTS:

A. President: Apologized to the representatives for not being able to do a complete "call-around" prior to the meeting. Also apologized to the Griffins MC for failing to mail them a copy of a letter, requested by them, in a timely manner. Remainder of remarks will be held for the appropriate portions of the meeting.

B. Vice-President: There is no quarterly calendar of events as no information on up-coming events had been received. The remainder of the report is deferred to New Business.

C. Treasurer: A copy of the Treasurer's report is attached. The patch inventory is extremely low. Anyone with information on a reasonable patch company should contact the treasurer with the information.

D. Secretary: Reviewed/read correspondence from Bucks MC, Highwaymen TNT and European Confederation of Motorcycle Clubs (ECMC). All potential hosts for future AMCC meetings are requested to have the services of an interpreter available for said meeting to allow Justin's full participation. The supply of letterhead stationary is also very low. Anyone who can get a lower price than the

VI. Committee Reports: The chair thanked Lee H. and Mark B. (Thunderbolts MC) for their assistance in coordinating AMCC's participation in the NYC Gay Pride March. He also thanked Jerry M. (Excelsior MC) for serving as his "deep-throat" within the March committee.

Lee H. noted that the event went well, especially the biker's contingent.

A discussion followed regarding media coverage and the improper identification of the persons wearing "G" strings. Apparently a NY bike club was mistakenly identified as the "daring dandies" when the "culprits" were in fact from Pennsylvania (present at the invitation of the NY club, it was noted). It is hoped that a presentation/display of photographs will be available at the 105th meeting.

Excelsior MC noted that most of the bikers also participated in the candlelight vigil on the evening prior to the March.

VII. OLD BUSINESS:

A. There were no corrections, additions or deletions to the 1992 Sanctioned Calendar.

B. IML Suite Reception: The Chair reported that the AMCC reception for MAC was a rousing success. A report of the expenses and additional club donations was provided by the Treasurer (copy attached). The Treasurer also thanked Marshall K. (Griffins MC) for his assistance.

The chair thanked the following clubs for their assistance before, during and after the reception: Centaur MC, Griffins MC, C.O.M.M.A.N.D. MC, Excelsior MC, Vanguard's MC, Empire City MC, Philadelphians MC, Entre Nous, Shipmates Club, Spartan MC and Vikings MC. Special thanks to Ed G. (Philadelphians MC) and Joey L. (Vanguard's MC). Also, to Bob K. (Entre Nous) for hotel arrangements and opening the Entre Nous suite to handle the overflow. The chair expressed appreciation and thanks to all the clubs who made donations. The Treasurer extended thanks to a former Shipmate, now residing in Chicago, for the advance work he did for us. Finally, the Chair thanked C. B. Miller and Joe Laing for their assistance.

Coverage of our party was shown on NY's Gay TV, primarily centering on an interview with C. B., but with other activities also recorded. MAC was sufficiently impressed that they requested we do a joint party in 1993. Regretfully, we declined due to our anticipation of Keelhaul

'93.

C. Discussions Between AMCC and MAC: Discussions are ongoing. Contact is maintained on a regular basis. We are reminded that MAC is saving space for AMCC in their newsletter. D. Other Old Business: Lost Angels noted that we should save our "clippings" and perhaps provide the most notable ones with the minutes. Entre Nous noted that Keith B. (Empire City MC) is the AMCC Historian and copies should be sent to him for the "archives".

VIII. NEW BUSINESS:

A. The Vice-President announced that only one request was received to host the 106th meeting. Therefore, the 106th meeting of the AMCC will be hosted by the Pennsmen during their 16th anniversary, February 12-13-14, 1993, in Harrisburg PA.

B. The floor was opened to nominations for the Torrid Tuber. There were none. The Chair noted that nominations would also be open at the 105th meeting.

C. Sanction requests for the 1993 calendar year were made. The proposed Sanctioned Calendar for 1993 is attached.

Spartan MC moved that immediate sanction be granted to the Philadelphians MC, Centaur MC and Pennsmen. The motion was seconded by Pittsburgh MC and passed.

Entre Nous renewed their suggestion of a "rolling" sanction which was noted but not discussed.

D. Other New Business:

1. Entre Nous moved that the Chair appoint a committee to determine AMCC's involvement in the March on Washington scheduled for April 25, 1993. The motion was seconded by Lost Angels.

A discussion ensued raising several points. The Chair noted the proximity of the event and suggested that the motion be amended.

Entre Nous amended their motion to read as

follows: Resolved that AMCC will participate in the activities of the March on Washington and that a committee be formed to work out the details of that participation. Lost Angels, as second of the original motion, agreed to the amendment. A vote was taken and passed unanimously.

The committee will consist of Empire City MC, Lost Angels, Centaur MC, Spartan MC, C.O.M.M.A.N.D. MC, Highwaymen TNT and Entre Nous.

Again, points regarding housing, money, travel and events were brought up. It was determined that the committee would hold their initial meeting at the close of the AMCC meeting.

2. Lost Angels moved that AMCC participate in the NAMES Project's final display of the entire quilt on October 9 and 10. The motion was seconded by the Griffins MC. Although the motion passed, it was suggested that interested clubs speak with Lost Angels regarding the details of the participation.

IX. CLUB ANNOUNCEMENTS:

A. Centaur MC: Brother Help Thyself (BHT) will hold Lock-Up III on October 7 at the DC Eagle from 9 P.M.. The Atlantic States Gay Rodeo Association (ASGRA) will hold their first rodeo in Washington DC from October 2 thru 4.

B. Bucks MC: Bar nite at the Bike Stop on September 20 from 4 to 8 P.M.. Also, Santa Saturday will be held on November 28.

C. Pittsburgh MC: Will jointly host with the Crucible MC the 9th Annual Mr. Pittsburgh Leather contest on November 14. During the period November 15 thru December 15, Pittsburgh MC and Crucible MC will sponsor "Teddy Bears Do Care", a benefit fundraiser. Also, on October 10 they will be doing a bar night at the Baltimore Eagle.

D. Spartan MC: Marathon '93 will tour the Smokey Mountains and lower Blueridge. Details will be forthcoming.

E. Lost Angels: BHT will present the premier of "Daddy in the Muscle Academy" on October 16. BHT will also be coordinating a candlelight vigil the evening before the March on Washington.

F. Pennsmen: Pocono Warriors and Satyrmens will hold a joint bar nite on October 3 at the Baltimore Eagle. On October 24, Pennsmen, C.O.M.M.A.N.D. MC and Three Rivers Leather Club will have a bar nite. On November 14, Pennsmen and Shipmates Club will jointly sponsor the first bar nite at the 14 Carat in York PA.

G. Vanguards MC: The 23rd Anniversary will be celebrated in Philadelphia October 15 thru 17 and will include a volley ball game with the Philadelphians MC.

H. Pocono Warriors: The 15th Anniversary will be celebrated in Philadelphia February 5 thru 7, 1993.

I. Griffins MC: A bar nite at the Red Star Saloon in Reading PA on October 24 and a bar nite at the Baltimore Eagle on November 21.

J. Entre Nous: P-Town Pilgrimage will be October 23 thru 25, and Orlando is on schedule for march 1993.

K. Philadelphians MC: On October 11 will celebrate the 18th Anniversary with a brunch followed by a social from 4 to 8 P.M. at the Bike Stop. On November 21 will be doing a social at the Spike in NYC. Tri-Cen will be held from December 31, 1992 thru January 3, 1993.

L. Shipmates Club: On April 2 thru 4, 1993, will be celebrating their 19th Anniversary in Baltimore.

M. Iron Guard BC: On November 9 will hold their annual fundraiser for "God's Love We Deliver" at Sneakers in NYC.

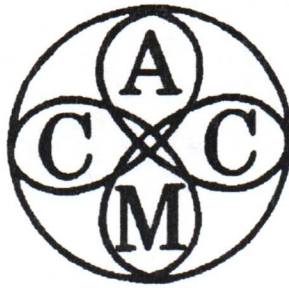
O. Ed Glaser: Rear Entry will be available to clubs for socials. Please contact him for details.
