# Atlantic Motorcycle Coordinating Council

- I. The 110th meeting of the Atlantic Motorcycle Coordinating Council was called to order at 10:35 P.M. by President Joe Laing at the Redwood Inn, Pittsburgh, PA
- IIA. PRESENT: Bucks MC, Centaur MC, C.O.M.M.A.N.D., Crucible MC, Empire City MC, MC Faucon, Griffins MC, Hartford Colts MC, Highwaymen TNT, Iron Guard, Long Island Ravens MC, Philadelphians MC, Pittsburgh MC, ShipMates Club, and Spartan MC.

- IIC. ABSENT: Cycle/Wheels MC, Excelsior MC, Lost Angels, Pocono Warriors, Reading Railmen, Scorpions MC and SNC London.
- III. GUESTS: Various guests, including the President of The Mid-america conference, were introduced.
- IV. The minutes were amended to show the Reading Railmen present by proxy. This was done because all clubs having submitted a ballot on the proposed changes to The Articles having no member in attendance were considered present by proxy. On a motion by the Centaur MC (second by Iron Guard) the minutes of the 108th meeting were accepted as amended.
