meeting.

VI. COMMITTEE REPORTS:

C.O.M.M.A.N.D.'s Boot Camp - Perfect Size 8 will be Nov. 8- 10.

Centaur M.C. asked to withdraw their request to sponsor the 118th AMCC meeting at Olympia. Pittsburgh M.C. made to motion to accept seconded by the Reading Railmen. One opposed - Motion passed.

There has been no other requests to sponsor the 118th AMCC meeting. It was brought up that the council is able to hold one meeting a year at a non-sanction event. Some discussion went on regarding holding the 118th meeting at Olympia the fact that another club has already sanctioned that date. Paul Rose pointed out that this would be a definite violation of AMCC regulations -- end of discussion. Determination of the place/sponsor of the 118th AMCC meeting will be at the 117th meeting.
