117th Council Meeting  
July 6, 1996  
Kintnersville, PA

I. The 117th meeting of the Atlantic Coordinating Council was called to order at 12:45 P.M. by President Ed Glaser at Bucks M.C. Pow Wow '96, Kintnersville, PA.

IV. MINUTES: Correction to the minutes of the 116th AMCC Meeting - MC Faucon was present  
A motion was made by the Vikings M.C. to accept the minutes as corrected, seconded by C.O.M.M.A.N.D. All in favor - the minutes were accepted as corrected.

V. OFFICER REPORTS:

PRESIDENT: The president welcomed everyone to the 117th AMCC meeting and wished all a good weekend. An apology was given for forgetting the AMCC banner. Reminded attenders what the AMCC is all about and with that read the last paragraph in the By-laws. Thanked Bucks M.C. for host the meeting.

David Hunt, a former member of the outreach committee has moved out of the area, and a new representative from the New England area was sought. Bradley from Entre Nous volunteered for the committee.

ARTICLES COMMITTEE: At the last meeting the Articles Committee reviewed in detail the revisions to the Articles of Agreement. No comments were received by any members of the Committee since the last meeting.

Pocono Warriors asked why is an abstaining vote looked upon as a negative vote, This forces clubs to vote no. After discussion on this it was pointed out that the article in question was not changed by the committee it was only clarified. That is not to say that the Pocono Warriors do not have a valid question. This can be addressed, after the changes have been ratified, as an amendment to the Articles of Agreement.

There was a motion made by C.O.M.M.A.N.D. that the revision of the Articles of Agreement be presented for a vote at the next meeting, this was seconded by Entre Nous - All in favor.
