Secretary's Report 119th Council Meeting December 7, 1996

- I. The 119th meeting of the AMCC was called to order at 1:25 by President, Ed Glaser, at Raymonds Cafe, in New York City, NY.

- IV: MINUTES: A motion was made by Entre Nous to accept the minutes, seconded by Shipmates Passes.
- V: OFFICER'S REPORTS:

President: Apologized for not being at the last meeting - thanked all who helped out.

Vice President: Reviewed mail; PMC withdrew request for the 121 meeting, Night Hawks requested the 121 or 122 meeting in Virginia June 20 - 21, Shipmates requested that the 122 meeting be held at Keelhaul August 23 - 25, Highwaymen TNT requested a meeting for May 1998 to be held at their 20th Anniversary.

Treasurer: Reported that we had the same balance as last meeting - \$311.69. There is a balance due to the Council of \$45.50.

Secretary: Apologized for not being at the last meeting. As requested by members a revised roster will be sent out with the next minutes.

VI. COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Outreach: Will try to schedule a meeting during February in Philadelphia. PO Box should be established in the DC area this would give a common ground for people to reply/respond to.

Articles Committee: Vote scheduled for later in the meeting.

VII. OLD BUSINESS:

A. Vote on revised Articles of Agreement Discussion:

*Jose (speaking for the Articles Committee) stated that the revisions should not fail due to the lack of interest of some clubs. This has been 2 years in the working, input has always been asked for. Paper/non-existing clubs should not hold up progress. Regardless of sanction people will go to the runs they want. *A vote is needed to place it on the table - club which took it off the table must

make the motion to place it back on.

*Two 'no' votes will kill the Revision because 4 clubs are absent. There are 2 no votes already here by proxy.

*Long Island Raves made a motion to put the vote for the Revised Articles of Agreement back on the table. Bucks M.C. seconded - passes.

*Pennsmen votes no because we are voting on entire package and they oppose section VIII-C "No other interclub activity shall be held in conflict with a sanctioned event lasting thirty hours or less and which occurs within a one hundred fifty mile radius of the site of such a sanctioned club." They feel it should be 100 miles not 150.

*A suggestion was made to vote on the revisions change by change instead of on the entire package.

*The Articles Committee said that voting on the Articles of Agreement change by change could leave articles in opposition to each other.

*MUCH discussion on clubs who have not been attendance.

*The Outreach Committee emphasized how very important this revision is to their work and also that the committee and all of us should not only be looking for new clubs but should be working with current clubs who are in trouble.

*Empire City made a motion that the committee accept the Pennsman suggestion to change article VIII-C to read 100 miles instead of 150 miles.

*This cannot be done unless all clubs are notified.

*A vote on the revised Articles of Agreement is held: Results are 16 yes votes 18 are needed - does no pass.

*A request was made TO list the way individual clubs voted - it follows.
