- A letter by the President which was sent to him from The Pittsburgh MC. These issues were brought forward.

 - The current set being used is not the original. This set was originated by Ed Glaser. From good authority, the original set is in a house called Tara in Fire Island. Excelsior MC has been dispatched by the President to see if they can locate it and report back to the council. We should have a update by the next meeting.

 - The issue was discussed by club representatives. 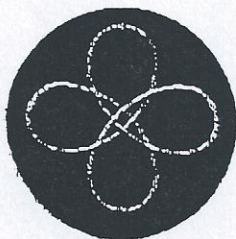
