Minutes of the 135th meeting held in Albany, NY during the STARS MC Empire State Leather Weekend on 7 April 2001. President, Al Lawrence at 1:07 PM, called the meeting to order.

MINUTES

Motion by Defenders MC to accept the minutes of the 134rd meeting: **Seconded** by Potomac MC; no corrections; **APPROVED**

Spartans MC asked that President Lawrence raise the volume to his usual level. (the normal loud)

OFFICER'S REPORTS

President Lawrence made a special presentation to the last AMCC President, Dan Dutcher in the form of a plaque thanking him for his years of service to the Council. The group responded with a standing ovation. **SECRETARY:**

- -- I have received all the club certifications for 2001.
- -- AMCC has received various bar flyers and club announcements. Anyone caring to see any of them please see me after the meeting.

VICE PRESIDENT:

- -- Vice President Hein reports that he has received two requests to host the 136th AMCC meeting from the Defenders NY and the Utica Tri's. Both have neither hosted a meeting so each have infinity scores. Therefore, since it is a tie, the Council membership will vote on it during new business.
- -- A newsletter committee will also be forming. We hope for volunteers.

PRESIDENT REPORT:

--There has been considerable difficulty with the last Treasurer, Brad Lee Hall. As of last week, we got an accounting and all the funds, patches, and Treasury records will be shipped to President Lawrence this week. Some monies are long overdue and President Lawrence has lent the Council funds to operate and checks can be written today to reimburse individuals with outstanding obligations of the Council. The loaned funds will be repaid to President Lawrence when the funds are received from past Treasurer Hall. In the event they do not arrive for whatever reason, the Presidential septor may find another use.

TREASURER REPORT:

-- Treasurer Saavedra reports he will be working on a budget to be presented at the next business meeting in Rhode Island. A bank account will be set up in the AMCC's name in Baltimore, MD.

OLD BUSINESS

ADDITIONS, DELETIONS, CORRECTIONS TO THE 2000/2001 SANCTIONED CALENDAR:

Defenders NY – It is the 20th Anniversary Empire City – It is the 38th Anniversary Potomac MC – Dates are June 8-10

ALL COUNCIL CONFERENCE:

-- Awaiting the finalization of the agenda.

- --The first meeting was hosted by the KC Pioneers of MAC and the objective was to facilitate better communication between the Conferences in the USA and down the road internationally. The second meeting will be held during the Highwaymen Run May 11-13 in Washington, DC.
- -- President Lawrence asked what appropriate items the AMCC member Clubs would like to see on the agenda which have not been previously discussed. Please keep in mind that the sovereignty and autonomy of all Clubs must be considered.
- -- Since AMCC will be the host for the meeting, Secretary Urbanski will act as the Secretary for this meeting. Past AMCC President Dutcher will serve as the facilitator during the meeting. The meeting should be one hour and a half to two hours long.
- -- Mr. Dutcher states the goal is to exchange information, calendars, and rosters. The second meeting may be more expansive than the first with an emphasis on how to improve on communication and to explore the evolution of Clubs. Again, the intent is not to interfere with the internal affairs of any Club. One question which may be explored is why younger individuals interested in the leather community are not joining Clubs particularly in many large cities.
- --All Clubs can attend the Conference whether they are members of a Council or Conference now or not. Potomac MC asked if this is inclusive with regard to including organization's which are not "traditional" backpatch Clubs (ie bear, pansexual, straight etc...) President Lawrence responds that although our focus has been on gay backpatch leather Clubs, it is up to the membership of each of the Conferences to decide on what course of action will be taken with regard to these other kinds of groups.
- -- Items on the agenda include but are not limited to the following;
- a. process for selection of future host sites including a rotation system of host sites between the Conferences involved
- b. Linking of Conference websites
- c. Promotion of Club events .. contests and runs
- d. Improving foreign relations
- e. Issue of female members in traditional leather clubs
- f. Issue of bear Clubs and their role in Conferences

AMCC's position with regard to (e) and (f) is that our Articles stipulate requirements for membership. The decision as to what each member club allows is their's alone. Please forward any additional suggestion for agenda item to VP Hein at vasailor@aol.com.

DC BOYS OF LEATHER AMCC CLUB MEMBERSHIP:

--DC Boys of Leather sponsored by ShipMates and Defenders NY has applied for AMCC membership. They came to the Executive Council prior to this meeting and stated that the number of members they have today if not sufficient to meet AMCC requirements for membership. Excelsior made a **Motion** which was seconded by the Iron Guard that the DC Boys of Leather can be voted in for membership at a future AMCC meeting provided that all Clubs receive a 30 day notice prior to a vote informing them that the requirements for membership have been satisfied. **MOTION PASSED**

NEW BUSINESS

LOCATION OF THE 137th:

-- Two Clubs submitted requests for hosting the 137th meeting, Defenders NY and the Utica Tri's, which were submitted according to the procedures outlined in the Articles of Agreement. VP Hein read the procedures to the Member Clubs in Attendance (Fair and Equitable Hosting of Meetings).

- -- Since both of these groups have never hosted a meeting, the result is a tie in points. Therefore, according to the AMCC Articles of Agreement, a vote of the Member Clubs is required to break the tie. A vote was taken and counted by neutral observers, the Promethian Guard. The host of the 137th meeting is the Defenders NY with the meeting taking place in New York City on November 10, 2001 during Indulgence.
- --The Enforcers RI in Providence, RI will host the 136th meeting on August 4th during their Run Aug 03-05, 2001.
- -- Requests for the 138th meeting are due to Vice President Hein (per AMCC Articles of Agreement) in writing at least 30 days prior to the meeting (July 3, 2001) hosted by the Enforcers RI on August 4, 2001. The date of the 138th meeting cannot be before January 11th, 2002.

PROMETHIAN GUARD AMCC CLUB MEMBERSHIP:

- -- The Philadelphians and the Iron Guard sponsor the Promethian Guard of New Jersey for membership in the Council. They attest that they meet the AMCC requirements for membership to the best of their knowledge. The vote on their potential membership will occur at the Enforcers Run on August 4, 2001
- -- The Promethian Guard addressed the group and state that they started in January 1999 and were chartered in May of that year. They are based in NJ, generally the Ashbury Park area. Sal Sissino of the Promethian Guard thanks their sponsors as well.
- -- After all guests were excused from the room, members of the Pocono Warriors, COMMAND, and the Bucks MC all made favorable comments about this group.

AMCC BROCHURES:

-- The Knight Hawks of VA made a **Motion**, seconded by the Highwaymen that the Council fund two sided legal color copies of the brochure for an amount not to exceed \$400. **MOTION PASSED**. The individuals charged with this task are to get as many copies as possible for the \$400 (hopefully in excess of 500) and to have them ready for distribution by 5/12 for the Conference of Conference Meeting.

AMCC BANNERS:

- Centaur MC announces that Doug Gowan is prepared to make an AMCC banner for any AMCC member Club who wants one for a cost of approximately \$35.

AMCC PATCHES:

-- A **motion** was made by the Centaur MC and seconded by the Excelsior MC to purchse 250 AMCC patches. **MOTION PASSED**

FUTURE TORRID TUBER NOMINATIONS:

-- A **motion** was made by the Pocono Warriors and seconded by the Empire City that all nominations for the torrid tuber must be made only for Club events which have been completed. **MOTION PASSED**

AMCC FUNDRAISING BAR NIGHTS:

- -- President Lawrence reminds group that the last two fundraising bar nights the Council had were done primarily to fund outreach efforts. Perhaps, we may have strayed away for using the funds entirely for that purpose. A discussion ensued in the group that it is also nice to not have assessments due to the fact the Treasury is solid after we have one of these bar nights.
- -- A discussion followed about have a fundrasing bar night in Philadelphia one of the two last weeks of September since no Club has a sanctioned event at that time. Rich D'Amico from the Philadelphians will follow up with the Bike Stop and report back to Executive Council. A "fun" bar night in Harrisburg was also discussed, the date to be determined. The Pennsmen will investigate dates and report back to the Council.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

President Lawrence states that all the committees; Outreach, Motorcycle Riders, and Communications will be reformed at this meeting. He thanks all the past committee members for their efforts and welcomes all to participate in these committees for the upcoming two year term. Additionally, President Lawrence asked that prior to each AMCC meeting that each committee have a meeting to discuss issues pertinent to its function and what needs to be accomplished.

OUTREACH COMMITTEE:

- -- The following individuals volunteered for this committee; Mel Jacobs (Centaur MC), Connie Cox (Defenders NY), Peter Lloyd (Potomac MC), JD Jarnett (COMMAND), Tom Urbanski (Knight Hawks), Doug Hein (Highwaymen) and Jim Green (LI Ravens). President Lawrence stresses the importance of having outreach extend both to prospective new members of the Council as well as those Clubs who are already Council members who may need the assistance and help of the Council. Jim Green of the LI Ravens is named the chair of this committee. A meeting of this committee will take place tomorrow afternoon after brunch.
- -- The AMCC brochure was discussed with Paul Rose stating he has the zip disk of all the Club's logos and the brochure. The Utica Tri's colors will be added to the brochure, any prospective applicants to the Council will not be added until they are voted in as Council members. This item was discussed again during new business.

-- The following individuals volunteered for this committee; Jose Reyes (Empire City), Paul Rose (Spartan MC), Mike Newsome (Potomac MC), Bob Opperman (Bucks MC), and John Dietz (LI Ravens). President Lawrence names Jose Reyes as the chair of this committee. Secretary Urbanski states he has the Motorcycle RidersInter Club Riding Rules booklets on hand if anyone would like some.

COMMUNICATIONS COMMITTEE:

- -- The following individuals volunteered for this committee; Victor Skolnik (Excelsior), Jose Reyes (Empire City), Jack Goldstein (Utica Tri's), Don Hinkle (Philadelphians MC), Doug Hein (Highwaymen) and Paul Rose (Spartan MC). President Lawrence names Doug Hein and Paul Rose as co-chairs of this committee.
- --This committee's primary function is to facilitate communication among both members of the AMCC as well as among other interested members of the leather/SM/bear/fetish/motorcycle communities. This committee will encompass both the website and the newsletter. The goal is to produce an electronic newsletter within the AMCC website. This will be a quicker and cheaper way to get the word out.
