

Minutes of the A.M.C.C. meeting held in Boston, Mass. during the Vikings M.C. B02-2271 (Washington's Birthday Weekend Run) on February 13,1971.

The meeting was called to order by the President at 4:35 p.m.

The Secretary read the minutes of the previous meeting, and as there were no additions, deletions, or corrections, they were accepted as read.

Since the A.M.C.C. Treasurer was not present, the official Council Financial Report was not given. (Unofficially, Don Bruce reported that after the check was given to Cycle M.C., the balance in the treasury was \$.54)

pon Bruce read a letter from Duke St. Pierre, President of the Rocky Mountaineers M.C. (Denver, Colorado). Briefly, Duke felt that because of the distance factor between the West and the East Coast, and the fact that he and few of his club members have been able to attend any of the A.M.C.C. meetings or functions, that they withdraw their membership from the A.M.C.C.

Don Bruce then read another letter from <u>Gene Simonar</u>, <u>President of Second City M.C.</u>, (Chicago, Illinois). Briefly, Gene felt that the A.M.C.C. was not performing it's functions as a co-ordinating council as well as they could be, and for all best interests, announced it's resignation from the A.M.C.C.

## Old Business:

Carl Banks read the names for nomination of the A.M.C.C. Executive Officers to be elected at this meeting. Don Bruce then announced that any new nominations for A.M.C.C. Officers to be accepted from the floor. Since Second City M.C. Had withdrawn from the A.M.C.C. before elections were held, some of the posts had only one name for nomination.

We should also state in the letter that the A.M.C.C. and member clubs will promote and "advertise" their run dates as well as ours. All members at the meeting so agreed and the secretary was so instructed to write this letter.

Don Bruce then asked all of the New York City A.M.C.C. Clubs if they would co-ordinate one of their up-coming run dates with our 1972 A.M.C.C. Birthday Party. A suggestion was made that it could be held during Wheels M.C.'s "W-4" in May of 1972. "Mac" said he would have to confirm this with his club at their next meeting. Don said this could be a joint venture between Wheels and Empire City. A.M.C.C. elections for 1972 would also be held at this run. Fernando asked if his club could also serve cocktails at the Party.

A motion was made by Don Bruce that since Second City M.C. has withdrawn from the A.M.C.C. we only have three (3) A. M.C.C. meetings this coming year. These meetings will be haked as follows:

## NEW BUSINESS:

Marty Ballou (B. B. C.) then brought up the subject of the A. M. C. C. Patches and banners. Since this had been handled in the past by the A. M. C. C. Treasurer, (Gene Simonar, Second City), it would continue to be handled by the new Treasurer (Robby Robertson, Spartans).

Carl Banks made a motion that a letter be sent to the Vanguards (Philadelphia, Pa.) inviting them to join the A.M.C.C. This motion was seconded by Empire City, and voted unanimously. The secretary was so informed to write this letter.

All ratifications of the Articles of Agreement have been submitted, except Wheels M.C. "Mac" made a mental note to have it brought up at their next meeting for final approval.

Don Bruce made a motion that the meeting be adjourned. This was seconded and passed unanimously. Meeting was adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
