These are the minutes of the 150th AMCC meeting held at the Purgatory Bar in the Gifford House Inn in Provincetown, Massachusetts on Saturday, October 22, 2005 during the Entre Nous' Provincetown Pilgrimage run.

CALL TO ORDER

President Mel Jacobs called the meeting to order at 1:05pm.
