These are the Minutes of the 160th AMCC meeting held in Washington, DC on Saturday, July 4, 2009, during the DC Boys of Leather 10th Anniversary run.

CALL TO ORDER

President Steven James called the meeting to order at 1:05 pm.

MINUTES

A proposal to accept the Minutes of the 159th meeting was moved by Long Island Ravens MC and seconded by the Twilight Guard. **The motion passed**.

OFFICERS' REPORTS

Secretary's report: The Secretary passed out AMCC packets (minutes of the 159th meeting, sanction calendar, agenda for the 160th meeting). Updates to the AMCC contact list/roster were solicited from the membership. Secretary thanked the member clubs, all 2009 Annual certifications letters were received.

Treasurer's report: The Treasurer indicated that as of May 31, 2009, Council had a cash balance of \$2,270.46. No expenses to report since last meeting. Reminder made to member clubs that AMCC patches were available at \$3.00 apiece. Bank account was transitioned to TD Bank. Finalized budgets will be distributed at 161st meeting.

Vice President's report: The Vice President thanked member clubs for their help in keeping the nonsanctioned event calendar up to date.

President's report: The President welcomed all and thanked the DC Boys of Leather for hosting the 160th meeting of the AMCC. Acknowledgement of the 40th anniversary of the AMCC (4/5/09) was made. Mel Jacobs and Victor Skolnik were thanked for their service to the AMCC and recognized for their many contributions over the last 4 years.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Outreach Committee: Chairman is looking to re-organize committee and will be soliciting Council for new members. The May 9, 2009 AMCC All Club Bar Night at Triangles Café in Danbury, Connecticut raised \$480. Proceeds were split between AMCC and Interfaith of Danbury. Sean Campbell of the Twilight Guard thanked Council for hosting the event in Danbury.

The Committee continues to keep in contact, or initiate contact, with other clubs who might wish to enter Council, as well as supporting existing member clubs that need assistance.

Potential host site for the 2010 AMCC All Club Bar Night is being researched.

Location of the 161st and subsequent meetings

- The 161st meeting of the AMCC will be hosted by Empire City MC and held on October, 10, 2009 to coincide with leather weekend in New York City.
- The 162nd meeting of the AMCC will be hosted by the Philadelphians MC and held on Saturday, January 2, 2010 during Tri-Cen XIX in Philadelphia, PA.
- Excelsior MC and NE Pennsylvania Leathermen both submitted requests to host the 163rd meeting of the AMCC. After a review of the point system, Excelsior MC was awarded the request. Meeting to be held during their 35th Anniversary celebration/run in Fire Island, NY.
- -All member clubs were asked to be prepared to provide their sanction requests for the 2010 calendar at the 161st meeting in October.
- Nominations for the Award of Excellence will be recorded at the 162nd meeting in January.
- The DC Boys of Leather provided pricing information for the AMCC's 40th Anniversary pins. Vendor (Toss) costs are: \$.92/pin with an additional \$.10/pin for screw back. Secretary noted there are 463 members/pledges according to the 2009 certifications. A proposal to order 600 pins (@ \$1.02/pin) was moved by Long Island Ravens MC and seconded by the Harbor Masters. **The motion passed**. DC Boys of Leather graciously offered to fund the entire cost of the pin order. A decision to assess a per pin cost to member clubs as a potential fundraising effort will be brought to the floor at the 161st meeting.
