These are the Minutes of the 164<sup>th</sup> AMCC meeting held at Camp Saginaw in Oxford, Pennsylvania on Saturday, September 4, 2010 during the Centaur MC's Olympia XXI run.

### **CALL TO ORDER**

President Steven James called the meeting to order at 12:05 p.m.
