These are the Minutes of the  $165^{th}$  AMCC meeting held at The Hippo in Baltimore, MD on Saturday, November 6, 2010 during C.O.M.M.A.N.D. MC's Mr. Maryland Leather and  $22^{nd}$  Anniversary run.

### **CALL TO ORDER**

President Steven James called the meeting to order at 11:09 a.m.

A moment of silence to honor the life and contributions of past AMCC President and member of Centaur MC, Mel Jacobs, was recognized.

#### MINUTES

A proposal to accept the Minutes of the  $164^{rd}$  meeting was moved by Long Island Ravens MC,  $2^{nd}$  by Reading Railmen - **motion passed**.

### **OFFICERS' REPORTS**

**Secretary's report:** The Secretary passed out AMCC packets (minutes of the  $164^{th}$  meeting, the 2010/2011 sanction calendar and agenda for the  $165^{th}$  meeting). Updates to the AMCC contact list/roster and 2011 Sanction calendar were solicited from the membership.

**Treasurer's report:** The Treasurer indicated as of 11/1/10, Council had a cash balance of \$1,915.39. Reminder made to Member Clubs there were 277 AMCC patches in our inventory, available for purchase at \$3.00 a piece.

**Vice President's report:** The Vice President advised there were two requests made to host the 167<sup>th</sup> AMCC meeting – from the Knight Hawks of Virginia and the ShipMates Club of Baltimore. According the calculations defined in the Articles of Agreement, the 167<sup>th</sup> meeting was awarded to the Knight Hawks of Virginia. Requests for the 168<sup>th</sup> meeting and beyond should be submitted to

the Vice-President at least 30 days prior to the 166th meeting in Harrisburg on 2/26/11. A request was also made for additions to the non-sanctioned calendar for the remainder of 2010 as well as 2011.

**President's report:** Welcomed all to Baltimore and thanked everyone for supporting COMMAND's anniversary run.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Outreach Committee: No report

**Historian's Committee**: No report, however, it is noted that a recommendation was made by Twilight Guard that the Historian begin to document his memoirs and a number of Member Clubs spoke in favor, offering their assistance. A motion was made to purchase a voice recorder to help in the documentation of AMCCs history for future transcription, moved by Pennsmen, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Twilight Guard – **motion passed.** 

**Web Committee:** Committee discussed the consensus among its members to make stylistic and arrangement changes to existing website. Options will be reviewed and proposed at the 166<sup>th</sup> meeting. Committee also asked each Member Clubs to begin thinking about a short statement of purpose that could be placed on the AMCC web site that visitors could read before linking to individual club webpage/website.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

**Amendments and additions to the 2010 sanction calendar** – no changes for 2010. Secretary asked all Member Clubs who had not already provided submissions for 2011 to do so before the 166<sup>th</sup> meeting in Harrisburg.

The AMCC All-Club barnight hosted by NEPA in Scranton, PA had a good turnout – there were about 10 AMCC members in attendance and \$166.00 was raised for the treasury.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

## Location of the 166th and subsequent meetings

It was again noted that requests for the  $168^{th}$  meeting should be submitted in writing to the Vice-president no later than 30 days prior the  $166^{th}$  meeting and that a member of the requesting Club must be registered on the event and attend the AMCC meeting at which the request is discussed.
