In this date representatives from the above listed clubs met to form a group which will work to strengthen motorcycle clubs with mutual interests and to coordinate activities of these clubs. The Clubs present voted to form a council to be called "the Atlantic Motorcycle Coordinating Council." Following formation the below listed items of business and procedures were unanimously voted:

1. The officers will be a president, vice president, and secretary. Elected to these positions were:

- Bill Fitzmaurice - President (Spartan MC)
- Dick Doney - Vice-President (Vikings MC)
- Richard Kjelland - Secretary (Cycle MC)

2. The Clubs present at this initial meeting will form the charter membership.

3. New member clubs must receive a 100% vote of the membership to be admitted to the Council. It was voted to write the Rocky Mountaineers MC of Denver, Colorado, the 69 Club of London, England, and the Empire City M.C. of New York City to extend the offer of membership to them.

4. The Council will sanction one official winter social event and one official summer "run" per club. Each club is to submit its events and dates by June 1 to the Council President for inclusion on the Council Calendar covering 1969-70. Council events planned so far are as follows:

6. Meetings of the Council will be held on an irregular basis during the time of Council sanctioned social and motor-cycle events.

7. Each club is to submit as soon as possible a design for a Council emblem.

8. Dick Doney, having access to a tie-line will handle communications for the Council.

9. All news releases of the Council will be presented in Wheels.

10. Any expenses of the executive board of the Council will be submitted to the member clubs on a quarterly basis.
