OLD BUSINESS

The President ordered the Treasurer to order Patches in the same quantity as previously ordered. The Treasurer requested Member Clubs to write him concerning the required number of patches. The President thanked the D.C. Eagle for printing the A.M.C.C. calendars. Don B. suggested that the due dates for the 1974 calendar be submitted no later than November 30, 1973. Clubs were reminded to forward their Bike & participation trophy results to the President of the A.M.C.C. Please do not send them to Sam Johnson. The vote on membership of the Thunderbolts M.C. of Hartford and the Vanguard of Philadelphia was tabled until the end of New Business.

NEW BUSINESS

The President suggested that all clubs should be members of the council. He indicated he had received a letter from the Levi Guys of N.Y. indicating their desire to join the council and he hoped that Wheels M. C. would propose their membership at the next meeting of the A.M.C.C. He further indicated he hoped that all New York Clubs will come into the Council. Empire City M.C. discussed Teach-Ins. They offered their assistance to any club interested in organizing similiar events. Don B. suggested re-issuing A.M.C.C. handbooks to standardize procedures for group riding. Bob R. moved that the A.M.C.C. sponsor the showing of a film on cycle safety at Marathon 73. The cost to be approximately \$30.00. The motion passed unanimously.

The President then asked the guests to leave in preparation for balloting on membership applications. The vote for the Thunderbolt M. C. was taken by secret ballot. They were unanimously elected into the council. The vote on the ~~Vanguards~~ M.C. was taken by secret ballot. The vote was Yes 5 No 3 Abstain 2.

The President announced that he was unfamiliar with the exact wording of the amendment to the articles of agreement concerning voting requirements on membership. Due to the absence of the secretary the minutes of the Autumn Scrambles meeting were unavailable. After much discussion Don B. moved that the council would send revised copies of the Articles of Agreement to all clubs in the A.M.C.C.

After clarification of voting rules a revote on the Vanguards M.C. would be taken at Marathon 73. The motion passed unanimously.

Empire City moved: On voting for membership into the council ballots marked abstain would be counted with the majority. After considerable discussion the motion was withdrawn.

A motion was made to adjourn, it passed, and the President adjourned the meeting at 2:35P.M.
