

AMCC

The 46th meeting of the AMCC was held on August 6, 1977, at Altland's Ranch in York, Pa., in conjunction with Keelhaul '77.

The meeting was called to order by Walter K., president, at 12:50 p. m.

The following clubs were represented: Bucks, Empire City, Centaurs, L. I. Spuds, Lost Angels, N. Y. Levi, Praetorians, Scorpions, ShipMates, Spartans, Vanguard, and Wheels. The following clubs were not represented: Links, Kemo, Thunderbolts, SNC (proxy), and Iron Guard. Lou T. and Ted C. (Druids) and Jim L. (Pennsmen) were welcomed as guests.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Although the treasurer was not present, Walter K. noted that the balance should not have changed except for the purchase of the plaque presented to Tim T. The money owed AMCC '76 is still outstanding. The following clubs request AMCC patches: Spartans, 100; Vanguard, 25; Wheels, 25.

Don C. noted that a letter had been written to Kemo asking their intentions regarding AMCC, but no response had been received. He also reported that a letter of invitation had been sent to all non-AMCC clubs in the East north of Atlanta. Only Spearhead had responded.

Jim G. distributed copies of the Proposed Revision of the Articles of Agreement. He briefly reviewed these and the procedure necessary for adoption. It was decided that the secretary should send copies of the current Articles and the Proposed Revisions to each club. Each club is requested to review the proposals and be prepared to discuss them and suggest modifications at the next meeting. It is hoped that they can be voted on at the 48th meeting. It was decided that copies should be sent to Cycle, the Druids, Entre Nous, and the Vikings.

A motion was made that the next meeting of AMCC be held at Septemberfest, September 16, 17, 18, 1977. Seconded. Passed.

A motion was made that the 48th meeting of AMCC be held at Autumn Scrambles, November 4, 5, and 6, 1977. Seconded. Passed.

Don B. suggested that the Council should take an affirmative action stand by encouraging all bars and clubs to refrain from serving orange juice.

Walter K. suggested that clubs giving cocktail parties at runs should serve something that those who do not drink alcoholic beverages can drink.

For the good and welfare of the Council: Several clubs announced new officers, changes of addresses, etc. These are reflected in the revised list to be distributed at the next meeting. The following clubs used their time to announce coming events: Bucks, Santa Saturday, November 26; N. Y. Levi, Back-to-Back Bar Nights, October 21 and 22; Vanguard, Septemberfest, September 16, 17, and 18; ShipMates, Carnival, October 23; Praetorians, 7th Anniversary, October 8. Empire City noted that AMCC clubs should show interest in clubs outside the AMCC and support the whole Leather/Levi scene. Tim T., speaking for the L. A.'s, noted that two of the major deficiencies of the AMCC are failure of representatives to keep their clubs informed of Council activities and a lack of continuity. The Spartans thanked the ShipMates for their hospitality. The Centaurs noted that Gerry McChristian is still missing.

Walter K. thanked the ShipMates and the Revision Committee.
