Minutes of meeting #3 of August 17 approved as read.

By unanimous decision Dick Doney, Vice President had his status changed to that of an officer -- not representing a specific club.

The Cycle M.C. moved to abolish the secret ballot when admitting new club to the Council. It was generally agreed (but not voted on) that since the proxy votes, or absentee ballots would be used it would be most difficult to keep the votes secret. Second, it should be important to know how each club voted in case of a conflict so the new club sponsors would know ~~HOWEVER~~ who (which club needed selling) to approach. Or if a club were opposed they would know who to approach to explain why they didn't want the new club in the Council.

The purpose of the AMCC was challenged by the Empire City M.C. who were unaware of the basic platform of the AMCC as stated at the original meeting -- and this was then explained briefly by the President.

Beer Break

As a result of the previous discussion Empire City brought up the idea of splitting the AMCC into 3 Divisions. (A) Motorcycles only -- ECMC and SMC; (B) Motorcycle s and cars only -- Cycle M.C. and 69 Club; (C) Associated -- MC, Car and Non Transportation owners -- 2nd City, Vikings and Rocky Mountaineers; (D) Buddy Club -- SMCLA.

Empire City wished to table the motion that Wheels M.C. be voted in a member of the AMCC -- because of their being a "buddy club" (Not all motorcycles). Whereby the final vote, which was tabled at the last meeting, would be delayed until the next meeting to be held in NYC at the Empire City Run on October 19th. The Empire City M.C. stated that they had come to the meeting to "blackball" Wheels M.C.

The Cycle M.C. then withdrew their sponsorship of Wheels M.C., at which time the motion for sponsorship was re-submitted by the Viking M.C. and the SMC -- however the motion to table the nomination still stood.

INTERMISSION

After reconvening, Empire City stated that AMCC was not in accord with the Empire City since all AMCC members were not owners of motorcycles. In order to satisfy their demands the name of the council was changed to Atlantic MOTOR Coordinating Council. Empire City then withdrew its negative vote and Wheels M.C. was accepted as the 9th member of the AMCC.

The discussion of the Road Rules Booklet arose and was tabled.

Inter Club hospitality was discussed

"The AMCC whose main function is to coordinate among clubs having similar interest. Those clubs consisting of motorcycle clubs, motor clubs and buddy club" -- was the platform (name) change demanded by the Empire City in order to accept WHEELS.

The decision of the Council about the admission of any new club will be transmitted by the sponsoring club at the ~~time~~ the vote is taken.

Empire City passed out run invitation of the weekend run to NY.
