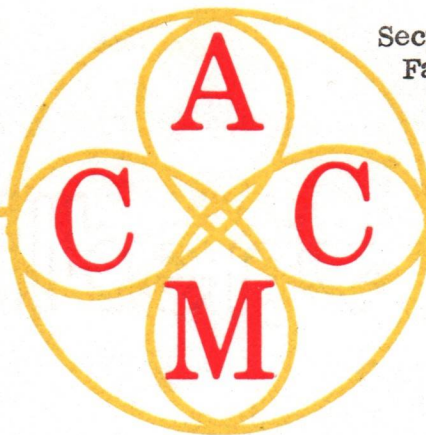

The 58th meeting of the AMCC convened at 11:55 a.m. on Saturday, Ides of March (15th), in conjunction with Entre Nous' 10th anniversary "Equinox" run in Boston. Council Pres. Don Craver (ShipMates) presided with all AMCC officers present. For the first time in recent memory, all Council members were represented in person or by proxy (Centaur's, Levis, Praetorians, SNC of London), as well as the Reading Railmen, candidate for Council membership. The Druids were represented as guests of the Council/Entre Nous.

#### OLD BUSINESS:

Secretary Roger Pegram (Vanguards) called the roll and read the minutes of the last meeting (December 1, 1979), which stood approved as read.

Council Treasurer Paul Rose (Spartan M.C.) gave the Treasurer's Report, showing a balance of \$166.71 as of 3-15-80. 328 new AMCC patches received at a cost of \$297.01, or @90¢. It was moved, seconded (Spuds/Vikings) and passed to charge @\$1.50 to member clubs. The Treasurer pointed out that the till is dangerously low, and that the Council consider a \$5 assessment per club to help rectify this condition. Rod Stine (Scorpions) suggested \$10 instead. Moved, seconded (T-Bolts/Entre Nous) and unanimously passed that the \$10 be assessed, pending individual club approval. The measure will be voted upon in May.

The Reading Railmen, proposed by ShipMates/Vanguards in December, were unanimously elected to Council membership, bringing total club representation to 23.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

President Craver announced the "AMCC '76, Inc." corporation papers (in D.C.) have been renewed. The President read a letter from Jim Gress, expressing regret that the Levi guys anniversary party on March 29 has been cancelled due to site problems.


The following changes/additions have been accepted in the 1980 sanctioned schedule: (1) Links: Anniversary, June 6-7; (2) Spartans: change from July 18-20 to July 11-13; (3) T-Bolts: July 28-29 for 9th anniversary; (4) Centaur's: 10th anniversary run, August 8-10; (5) Vikings: Labor Day Leif Eriksen run, August 29-Sept. 1. The Vanguards will not be holding their run on the sanctioned dates (Sept. 12-14), in all probability, having run into site problems. Further details will be announced. Reading Railmen 2nd anniv. - Oct. 5.

The Druids were proposed for readmittance to the Council (ShipMates/Entre Nous); the vote will be taken at the next meeting.

Invitations for next meeting received from Excelsior and the Bucks. Moved, seconded (Spuds/T-Bolts) and passed to hold next Council meeting in conjunction with Excelsiors' 5th anniversary in New York City on Saturday, May 19.

The President thanked Entre Nous for hosting the exceptionally nice brunch meeting. Motion to adjourn (Links/Vikings) at 12:30 p.m.
