All AMCC officers were present. The following clubs were present by proxy:
Links, SNC, Vikings, Warriors. The LI Spuds arrived late. The following clubs were absent: Iron Guard, Praetorians, Wheels. Ron Lord, Master at Arms of the Philadelphians MC was the only guest.

The minutes of the 66th Meeting of the AMCC were read and stood approved as submitted. The Treasurer handed out a written report. It showed a cash balance of \$779.48 with an inventory of 93 patches. The official copy of his report is attached to the official copy of these minutes.

The Secretary reported that the corporate papers had been filed and that all was in order with the government of the District of Columbia where the AMCC is incorporated. The address of the resident agent of the corporation, Don Bruce, had been changed to the current address of the DC Eagle, 908 7th St. NW, DC 20001.

## NEW BUSINESS

The Secretary announced that the supply of AMCC letterhead was nearly depleated. A ream had been ordered three years ago. He asked the Council's pleasure regarding ordering another ream. A price had been quoted of \$116 per ream.

MOTION (Vanguards/Spartan) Under the provisions of Article III of the Articles of Agreement, to place before the Council the Philadelphians MC for membership in the AMCC. [Under the provisions of Article 111, the vote on this motion is deferred until the 68th Meeting; representatives are hereby notified.]

ATLANTIC MOTORCYCLE COORDINATING COUNCIL

It was noted that the Council had received a letter notifying the clubs that a new club had formed in Pittsburgh, PA called the Steel Barons. They wished other (lubs to correspond with them and to advise where they could have patches made. It was noted with sadness that Cycle MC of New York had disbanded and that their publication Wheels Magazine had ceased to be published. This brought on a discussion about the need to continue an interclub publication.

MOTION (Faucon/Companions) That the AMCC provide a service in the form of a publication similar to the now defunct Wheels Magazine for the benefit of the member clubs and the leather/levi scene in PASSED without dissent general.
