## NEXT MEETING

Saturday, November 6, 1982  
Lost Angels' Run  
"Autumn Scrambles"  
Washington, DC

The 69th Meeting of the AMCC was called to order by President Keith Battin at 11:20am on Saturday, August 28, 1982, in St. Alphonse, Qué. Canada during MC Faucon's Run "Migration!" All AMCC officers were present. The following clubs were present in person: Bucks, Companions, Druids, Empire City, Entre Nous, Excelsior, Faucon, Iron Guard, Lost Angels, Philadelphians, ShipMates, Spartan, Spuds, Thunderbolts, Vanguard, Wheels. The following clubs were present by proxy: Links, Pennsmen, Praetorians, Railmen, Scorpions, SNC, Warriors. The following clubs were absent: Centaur, Vikings. The only guest was Armand Brunet, President, of the Spirit of St. Louis MC.

The minutes of the 68th Meeting of the AMCC were read by the Secretary and stood approved as read and submitted. The Treasurer gave his report in writing which showed a cash balance of \$789.72 and a patch inventory of 17. New patches are on order.

The President read a letter from a new club in Pittsburgh, PA called the Crucibles who wrote inquiring about the AMCC. A copy of the Articles of Agreement will be sent. The President then read a letter from the Druid MC announcing that they were disbanding, and thus withdrawing from AMCC membership, as of November 1, 1982. That letter is attached to the official copy of these minutes. The President expressed, on behalf of the entire AMCC, sorrow at this announcement.

## OLD BUSINESS

Concerning Tread Magazine becoming an interclub publication on a trial basis: the Vice-President stated that each club must send its material, article or flyer, directly to the Editor. Articles should be limited, edited, and properly written. The size of a full page is 7x8½. The deadline for the next issue is September 1. Future deadlines are November 1, February 1, and the end of April. The address to which to send articles and camera-ready copy for ads and flyers is: TREAD The Mark of Wheels MC, PO Box 615, New York, NY 10001. If you wish to subscribe, the cost is \$5.00 for six issues and the address to write to is the same. Currently, the Editor is Norman Oppenheimer.

The question regarding when elections would be held was put to a straw vote between considering the year a fiscal year (April 5-April 4) or a calendar year. Most felt that the year should be considered a fiscal year. A vote was then taken to decide when the 70th Meeting, for elections, would be held. The vote went to the Lost Angels. It was also felt that there would not need to be a meeting at the Philadelphians Run.


