ACCOUNTS DUE: All AMCC Clubs that have not already paid the \$3.27 for operating expenses of the AMCC were requested to do so immediately by forwarding checks made payable to W. FITZMAURICE at the address below.

PATCHES: It was announced that the cost of additional patches will be 62¢ each. It was urged that all orders and checks covering the amount should be sent IMMEDIATELY. Also, if no additional patches were desired this fact should be brought to the attention of the President of the Council. The order will be placed as soon as all Clubs are heard from. ROAD RULES BOOKLET: The Road Rules Booklet was accepted as presented at the meeting in Washington. Local rules (state) are due by March 1st. The Canadian provinces of Ontario and Quebec will be included. Chuck Rozema will be in charge of this addition.

AMCC NAME CHANGE: The ATLANTIC MIDWEST COORDINATING COUNCIL was chosen as the official name of the COUNCIL. Other names under discussion were the American Motor Coordinating Council which received one vote from the RMMC and the Atlantic Motorcycle Coordinating Council which received one vote from the Spartan M.C. Vote of the SMCLA was held by a proxy submitted by Don Bruce. After discussion, it was decided and voted on that the ATLANTIC MIDWEST COORDINATING COUNCIL would best represent the geographical areas covered by the AMCC.

WHEELS MAGAZINE: It was unanimously recommended that Wheels Magazine would be the best vehicle for disseminating news of the AMCC. It was suggested that it would be necessary for as many AMCC members as possible to subscribe in order to create an effective communications network among AMCC and allied Clubs. It was also strongly suggested that all AMCC Clubs supply WHEELS Magazine with a monthly column.

1970 RUNS: Don Bruce of the Spartan M.C. recommended that each AMCC Club only one AMCC sanctioned event each year. This was unanimously accepted by all representatives. However, since many important runs will be included in the schedule of individual clubs a secondary schedule will be reported in Wheels Magazine. Don also commented favorably on the policy of the Cycle M.C. in supplying the President of each AMCC Club with a complimentary ticket to any Cycle M.C. event that is AMCC sanctioned. (more)

NEXT AMCC EVENT: Applications for the BO 2 2270 will be supplied to Wheels Magazine for inclusion in the February issue. (It was pointed out by the Cycle M.C. during the meeting that each Club will be supplied with one FREE page in any issue of Wheels Magazine. The cost to be borne by the Cycle M.C. as a service to AMCC Clubs. The exception being if the club uses an insert. that event the cost of the insert must be borne by the host club.

AMCC MEETINGS: The time and place of the AMCC official meetings will be supplied well in advance by the President of the Host Club to the Presidents of all AMCC Clubs. And of course, to AMCC officers.

RUN COSTS: This was questioned by Andre Smith of the UYA. It was then explained that each club prices its own runs in relation to the individual cost and that the AMCC set no standards on this point.

STATEMENT OF POLICY:.....regarding the Chicago M.C. was voiced by Gene Simonar representing the 2nd City M.C. He stated that the 2nd City M.C. did not officially recognize the Chicago M.C. because they felt that the CMC did not share the mutual interests of the 2nd City and other AMCC Clubs. There are, however, several members of the Chicago M.C. who do share common goals and are recognized on a personal and individual basis.
