ATLANTIC MOTORCYCLE COORDINATING COUNCIL

1. GENERAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE

A. Introduction

The 74th Meeting of the AMCC was called to order by President Paul Rose at 12:37 p.m. on Saturday, December 3, 1983 at 'The Sunnycroft Ponderosa Ranch, Wallkill, N.Y., during the weekend of the Long Island Spuds' 'Horsin' Around.'

B. Roll Call

The following clubs were present in person: Bucks, Empire City, Entre Nous, Excelsior, Faucon, Iron Guard, L.I. Spuds, Lost Angels, Pennsmen, Pocono Warriors, Reading Railmen, Shipmates, Spartans, Thunderbolts, Vanguards, Vikings, Wheels. Represented by proxy were Centaurs, Companions and SNC London. Philadelphians, Praetorians and Scorpions were absent.

C. Minutes of the 73rd Meeting

The reading of the Minutes was dispensed with on the motion of Empire City/Thunderbolts and with the following corrections, all relating to Item 4A 'Sanctioned Event Calendar,' stood approved:

- 1) Excelsior 9th Anniversary is on May 19 vice May09
- 2) Vanguards' Anniversary is the 15th vice 16th
- 3) Philadelphians event is a New Year's Party vice 'Tri-Cen.'

E. Officers Reports

- 1) The President reported that a by-laws committee composed of Philadelphians (chair), Centaur and Iron Guard had been appointed pursuant to Item 4C of the 73rd Meeting Minutes. In addition, the President was in possession of offers to host the 75th Council Meeting from Centaurs and Shipmates.
- 2) The Vice-President stated that his calendar of significant member club activities (over and above sanctioned dates) was in preparation and would be available in the New Year.
- 3) The Secretary confirmed receipt of the requisite declaration from the Steel Barons concerning the eligibility of the club for AMCC membership and made his normal impassioned request that roster changes be brought to his attention.
- 4) The Treasurer submitted two reports:-
 - a) A final statement covering the period 11 June83-14 October 83.
 - b) The current statement for the period 15 October 83-02 December 83. The latter reflects a balance of \$540.86 and a patch inventory of 312.

2 CORRESPONDENCE

Other than those items specified above, there was no correspondence.

3. OLD BUSINESS

A. Ride Rules and Bike Events Committee

Referencing Item 3B of the 73rd Meeting Minutes, it was proposed by Thunderbolts, seconded by Bucks that the report submitted by the Committee be accepted. This motion passed without dissent.

The Committee will meet again in the New Year to consider bike event guidelines.

B. TREAD Magazine

The deadline for submission of articles for the next issue is 15 January 1984.

C. Joint Activity (North American)

Reference Item 4D of the previous Minutes, it was proposed by Empire City, seconded by Wheels that the concept of a joint activity with another North American conference be dropped. The motion passed. There were two abstentions.

D. Sanction Calendar

The following changes to the calendar of sanctioned events presented in Item 4A of the previous Minutes were as follows:-

- 1) M.C. Faucon released 07-09 September pending a re-appraisal of the clubs activities in 1984 by the new executive.
- 2) Iron Guard released 21 July
- 3) Pennsmen requested that their sanction be extended to include both 18 and 19 February.
- 4) Pocono Warriors released 04-06 May for one year and requested 10-12 August 1984 for 'Pocono Mountain Weekend.'
- 5) Praetorians requested, via Kevin Coughlin, that 6 October be their sanctioned date, even though this date co-incides with the existing Empire City date. Empire City stated that they have already discussed that matter with the Praetorians and have no objection. It was proposed by Shipmates, seconded by Bucks that the AMCC sanction both dates subject to the President of the Council receiving a letter signed by both clubs indicating that they have agreed to hold events simultaneously.
- 6) The Reading Railmen changed their sanctioned date from 14 October to 13 October 1984.
- 7) The Spartans extended their originally requested sanction dates from 24-26 August to 23-28 August 1984.
- 8) Vikings requested 31 August-3 September 1984 for 'Leif Erikson.'

It was proposed by Wheels/Railmen that the Sanction Calendar, as amended above, be accepted, which motion passed without dissent.

E. Voting - New Membership

Three clubs nominated for membership in the AMCC at the 73rd Council Meeting, having established their eligibility, were presented for election into the Council, namely, The Crucible of Pittsburgh, PA, The Steel Barons of Pittsburgh, PA and The

Wildcats of Norfolk, VA. After a secret ballot all three clubs were welcomed in as full council members, their being no dissent.

4. NEW BUSINESS

A. Torrid Tuber Award

Nominations for this coveted award were made from the floor as follows:-

Spartans - Proposed by Bucks, for bringing females to 'Keelhaul' for the purpose of belly-dancing when in fact so many club members were not only capable, but actually anxious to perform same.

Vanguards- Proposed by Empire City, for their thoughtfulness in keeping council delegates of a sober disposition throughout the 73rd Meeting by providing only coffee.

Companions-Nominated by the Vanguards for not issuing confirmations for their run.

Philadelphians- Nominated by Faucon for hosting a great run but not being able to make it themselves.

After many tense moments, Council President Paul Rose (Spartan M.C.) announced that this years winner was none other than Spartan M.C.
