I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Kevin Couglin at 12:20 p.m.

VI. APPROVAL of Minutes of July 27, 1985. On a MOTION made by the Spartans and SECONDED by Vanguard's, the minutes of the 80th meeting were ACCEPTED as amended in the copy distributed by Roger, with one further correction "The Treasurer read the Treasurer's Report".

VII. OFFICERS REPORTS
