MINUTES OF THE 87th MEETING -- JULY 25, 1987

# CALL TO ORDER

The 87<sup>th</sup> meeting of the AMCC was called to order by President Roger McEnnis at 1:05pm on Saturday, July 25, 1987, at Altlands Ranch near York, PA during the Centaur MC Olympia Run. The following clubs were present in person: Bucks MC; Centaur MC; Empire City MC; Excelsior MC; MC Faucon; Highwaymen; L.I. Spuds MC; Nine Plus; Pennsmen; Philadelphians MC; Pocono Warriors; Reading Railmen; ShipMates; Spartan MC; Thunderbolts MC; Vanguards MC; Vikings MC; Wheels MC; Wildcats MC.

The following clubs were present by proxy: Companions; Iron Guard; Pittsburgh MC; Praetorians; SNC London.

The following clubs were absent: Crucible MC; Entre Nous; Lost Angels; Scorpions MC; Steel Barons.

The following guest club was present: Cycle MC.

The President, Vice-President, and Treasurer were present. The Secretary was absent due to illness. The President appointed Paul Rose (Spartan MC) to take the minutes of this meeting.

# MINUTES OF THE 86th MEETING

The minutes of the  $86^{
m th}$  meeting were approved as submitted on motion of Empire City and seconded by the Pennsmen and passed without objection.

## REPORT OF THE TREASURER

The Treasurer's Report was submitted in writing and is made an official part of these minutes. In addition, the final report of the outgoing Treasurer, Mike Feeney of the Lost Angels, was also submitted in writing and it also is made an official part of these minutes. Mr. Feeney's report covered the period January 18 - April 5, 1987, and showed a cash balance of \$968.43 and a patch inventory of 120. The report submitted by the current Treasurer, Mike Hayslett of the Wildcats, covered by period April 6 - July 25, 1987, and showed a cash balance of \$268.46 after income of \$71.00 and expenses of \$782.34 and a patch balance of 434 with the Vikings owing \$3.00 to the AMCC for patches ordered but not paid. On motion of the Reading Railmen and seconded by the Vanguards the two Treasurer's Reports were accepted without objection.

# REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT

Roger McEnnis asked that the Council observe a moment of silence in memory of Robert Hullen of the Praetorians. The President reported that Cycle MC had formally submitted a letter requesting membership in the Council. He also noted that additional copies of the AMCC Ride Rules are available.

## MEMBERSHIP CERTIFICATION

According to the Articles of Agreement, each member club is to certify the total number of active members and pledges for active membership to the Secretary on or about January 1 of each year. The following clubs have not yet submitted their certification:

## VOTE ON ADMISSION OF CYCLE MC

Having requested membership in the AMCC and having been sponsored by at least two current member clubs and having been placed in nomination at the 86th Meeting, the vote by ballot to admit Cycle MC was now taken. Ballots were distributed while the clubs were reminded that an 80% affirmative vote by the entire voting membership was required to admit. Cycle MC of New York City was admitted to membership.

#### NEW BUSINESS

The Philadelphians MC had requested to host a meeting of the AMCC. The President asked whether the Council wished to hold a meeting prior to January 2, 1988. The clubs indicated no desire to meet before that date. The Council accepted the offer of the Philadelphians MC to host the 88th Meeting of the AMCC during their Tricen Run, December 31, 1987 - January 3, 1988, in Philadelphia.


# GOOD AND WELFARE


