B) AIDS Committee Report

in first need of AZT or other experimental drugs. This
money would be provided as a loan.

On a motion by Pittsburgh MC and seconded by Scorpions the Committee report is accepted

But after careful consideration, The AMCC leaves reluctantly, to each individual Clubs, the work of raising funds for local or regional AIDS Groups. Proposed by the Shipmates seconded by the Philadelphians with one against this motion is passed.

The President thanks the committee for their work.

On a motion by MC Faucon seconded by the Highwaymen it is proposed that all AMCC clubs may use the Name of AMCC for AIDS benefits that are organised within good taste. The motion carries with no objections.

IX. NEW BUSINESS


Pittsburgh MC wishes to thank the coustil for showing in such large numbers and hope they are all having a good time.
