PROPOSAL

IT IS PROPOSED THAT THE CONSTITUTION AND SY LAWS OF THE LAPIRE CITY MOTORCYCLE CLIE BE CHARRED IN THE FOLLOWING MANNER:

MIMBLERSHIP DULY shall be assessed at the rate of \$5 per month; \$14 per quarter; or \$52 per year. A quarter shall be defined as any three-month period; Quarterly dues and yearly dues shall be paid in advance and shall not include any month or months that are in arrears at the time of advance payment. This amendment shall in no way effect or change the due dates of membership dues, the paid-up requirement for voting privileges or any other condition of membership based on dues, in effect at the time this amendment is adopted.

This amendment shall become effective July 1, 1974. Those members showe dues are paid beyond July 1, 1974 shall not be required to meet the requirements of this amendment until such time as the expiration of their paid period is reached. No member shall be permitted to pay advance dues during the period between the adoption of this amendment and July 1, 1974

PROPOSAL

IT IS PROPOUED that the Constitution and By-laws of the EMPIRE CITY MOTORCYCLI CLUB be changed in the following manner:

The status of AS.OCITE MEMBER be established to permit the bestowal of a degree of membership on persons not entired to full active membership due to their residence, other club affiliation or their not meeting fully, the established requirements for active membership in the club.

Those persons being granted ABSOCIATE MEMBER status shall not be required to attend meetings of the club, and shall not be assessed dues in the manner of Active Members.

ABSOCIATE MEMBERS shall not be permitted to vote on any matter of club business, but their advice and opinions will be welcomed. They will be permitted to attend club meetings, whenever adviseable.

The names of persons being proposed for ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP shall be presented at a regularly scheduled quorum meeting of the club, and shall require no less than two sponsers. The voting on the proposed ASSOCIATE MEMBER shall take at place/the meeting immediately following the meeting at which the proposal is made.

The voting on AS OCI TE MEMB Rs shall be by secret ballot and shall require two-thirds of the members present to vote affirmatively in order to be carried.
