FIRST READING AT MEETING OF FEB. 19, 1975.

Constitutional ammendment

Article III  
Section I  
Paragraph 2

\*\*

Applicants for active membership must be recommended by 2 members in good standing. The Applicant must have attended one meeting. Upon payment of \$5.00 initiation fee, applicant will be placed on Pledge status until he has attended three meetings and participated in one club supervised ~~xxx~~ ride within a period of 8 consecutive weeks. At the expiration of that time, his application will come before a membership meeting. If a majority of the active members vote "yes" in secret ballot, and if fewer than 3 members vote "no", he will be considered a "Probationary Member" and will be entitled to vote, but will have no other privileges of a full member. Upon completion of 5 months of a successful probationary period, his conduct having been satisfactory, his application will come before another membership meeting. If a majority of the active members present vote "yes" ~~and~~, in secret ballot, and if fewer than three members vote "no", he will be considered a full member and will be entitled to all privileges of the club.
