VALINOR

Valinor is a privately owned residential facility. When friends make a reservation for events here there is no charge. If you desire you may make a donation to your favorite Charity. Many groups have made a Federal Income Tax Deductable donation to "Valinor Farms, Inc.", Country Living for People with AIDS--established at 3378 Winding Road, of from \$4 to \$10 per person per 24 hrs &/or portion thereof, most at \$8. Some have provided meals for the PWA Residents. Food left here after an event, unless otherwise specified, is considered donated to the PWAS in the residence.

Reservations (no contract) are accepted for from 10 to 100 (?). The main room will comfortably seat 84 at one time. All must conserve water for the limited well supply and especially the septic system. The dormitory will sleep up to 50 (Bed rolls or sleeping bags required) Any more will require Tents. If you cancel an event release the date as soon as you know.

While there are pets here, no other pets are permitted. No smoking in any interior space on the premise. No Nudity or "questionable behavior" in any area visible from the road or to visitors at 3378. Prescription and legal-over-the-counter medications only permitted--NO DRUGS. No unsafe sex practices in any interior space. All traffic and parking in designated areas--do not drive over buried water, septic, or electric lines. No one is to DRIVE away from Valinor if intoxicated.

Those making reservations shall be responsible for a Life Guard at the Pool when actively in use (either hired--Bob B, (215)536-8097 is certified and has been used here--or delegated to a qualified, responsible person). There must always be others in the pool area for ANYONE to use the Pool or Spa. No glass is allowed in the pool area. The pool area will be locked when the Life Guard is off duty, usually 2 AM to 11 AM.

They shall be responsible for all food and its preparation (Ed S. , (201)433-6218 has catered events here), beverages, paper products as towels, napkins, hot and cold cups, plates, toilet tissue (Prefer no styrofoam) and separation of waste material to recycle (Aluminum cans, Glass, Newspaper, Vegetable waste for compost) burnables, and all other (Tin cans, Aluminum foil and pans, plastic, etc.) They will be responsible for \$2.00 per trash bag of the "all other", and that not separated as above. This is picked up by DelGuericco's Disposal Service. Complete cleanup required before you leave.

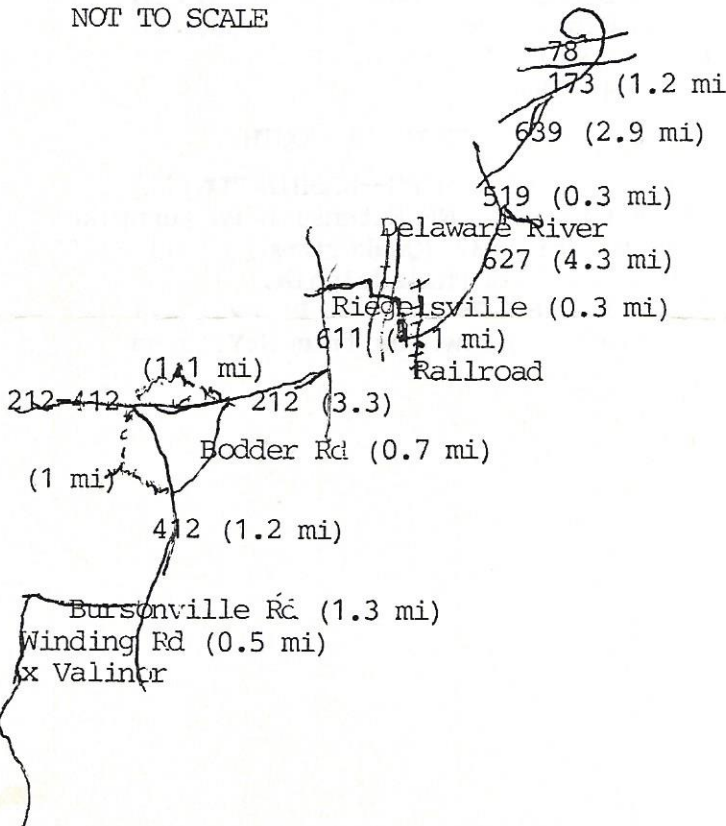
