So, how do you make color?

Those dots and their intensity regulate dark and light. The more concentrated the dots the darker, right? The less concentrated the lighter.

So —

Here is the color key for black to white:

Black - Santa's belt & boots. Santa's buckle is not black but lighter.

- Bearded man's cap and vest (and perhaps beard & hair)
- plaid shirted man's belt
- kneeling man's trousers (his ass)

and boots.

Red - Santa's suit (for trim exception) & gloves
 Bearded man's trousers
 plaid shirted man's trousers
 total distant man on right -- this guy is all one color

All ribbons on packages


(you choose his left hand should be noticed)

Brown - Santa's bag
Kneeling man's hair

gray - background
doll's dress
mag clown (foreground)

Flesh - everyone's (except fellow distant right -- he's at-red: Faces, hands, chests, arms, shoulders

white - Santa's beard, fur trim, ~~packages~~
(except for ribbon)

HERE IS SOME INFORMATION WHICH YOU MIGHT FIND HELPFUL.....

HINTS FOR GIFT SELECTION

Infants: Toys or clothing

Young girls: toys, games, accessories, sports items, racing cars

Teen-age girls: Records, accessories, jewelry, overnight bags, umbrellas, jewelry boxes, billfolds, belts, watches, radios, cameras, natural bristle hairbrushes, bedroom accessories, hair dryers, knitting and needlework kits

Teen-age boys: Records, sports books, toiletries, natural bristle hairbrushes, accessories, belts, radios, sports items, wrist watches, wallets, cameras, pen and pencil sets, jewelry, posters, games

If in doubt, try to select a present for a teen-ager, since over half of the youngsters in our care fall into that category.

You do not have to wrap the gifts. It is easier for our staff to select the right present for the right child if they are visible.
