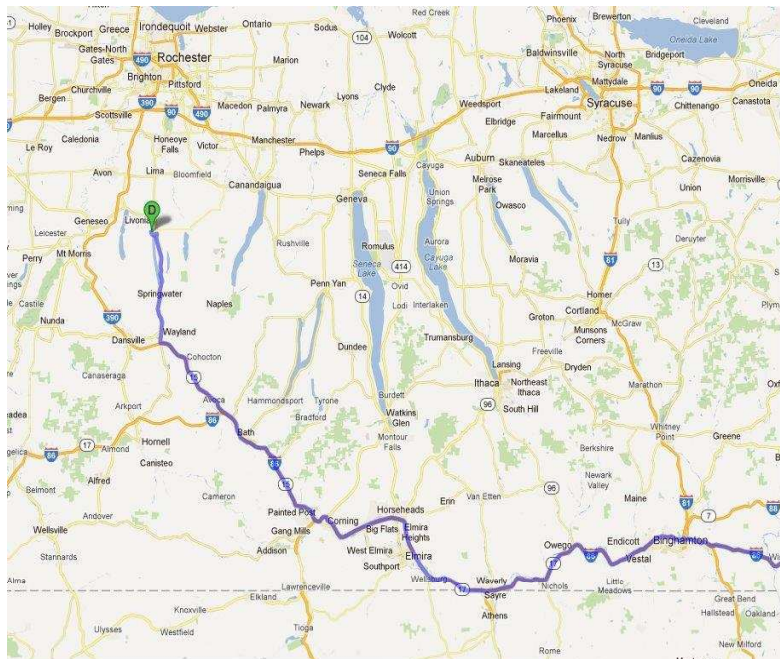

Now on to the planning...

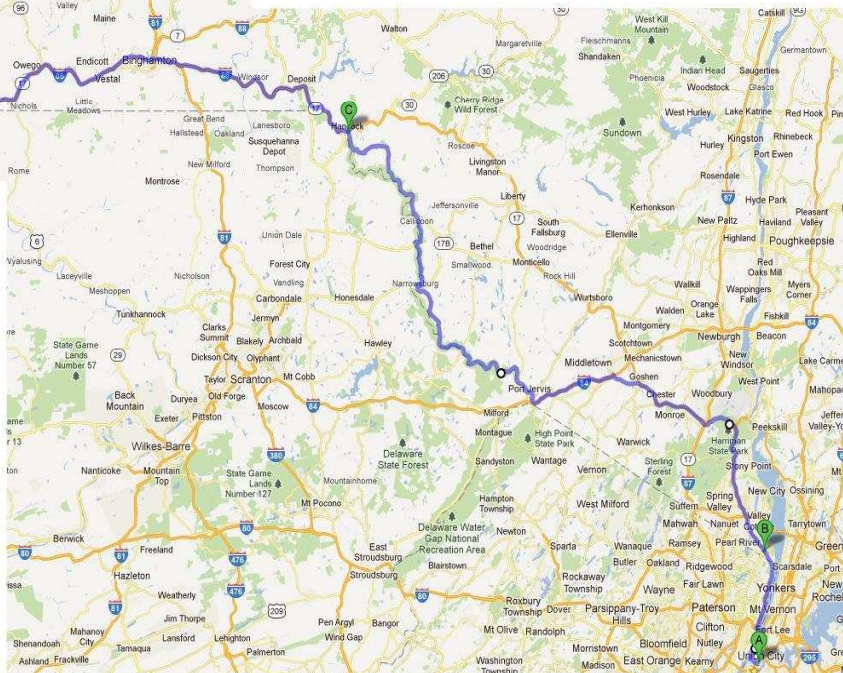


Stop A, 8AM/9AM – Meet at the Lexington Candy Shop, 1226 Lexington Ave, New York, NY 10028 for breakfast. If you want to eat breakfast, please arrive no later than 8AM. We shall depart at 9AM sharp! The Lexington Candy Shop is a classic 50’s malt shoppe with a hearty breakfast and smooth coffee! Note: Breakfast here is “dutch treat”.

Stop B, 10AM – Meet up with us at the Citgo gas station on the Palisades Parkway just beyond mile marker 12 when heading north. Be ready with full tanks and empty bladders! Meet in the large parking lot on the north side of the rest area. We will leave at 10AM sharp from this stop. We will ride up the picturesque Palisades Parkway to US-6 and then onto a fantastic road for riding road that follows the river, featuring some nice twisties up NY-97, ending in Hancock, NY.

Stop C, 1PM/2:30PM – Lunch! Empire City M/C treats you to a prix fixe menu at “Honest Eddy Murphy’s Tap Room” in the Hancock House Hotel (137 E Front St, Hancock, NY 13783). We will arrive around 1PM, eat, stretch and then we will gas up and depart no later than 2:30PM. There is ample parking in back of this wonderful restaurant and bar where we can relax and grab a bite.

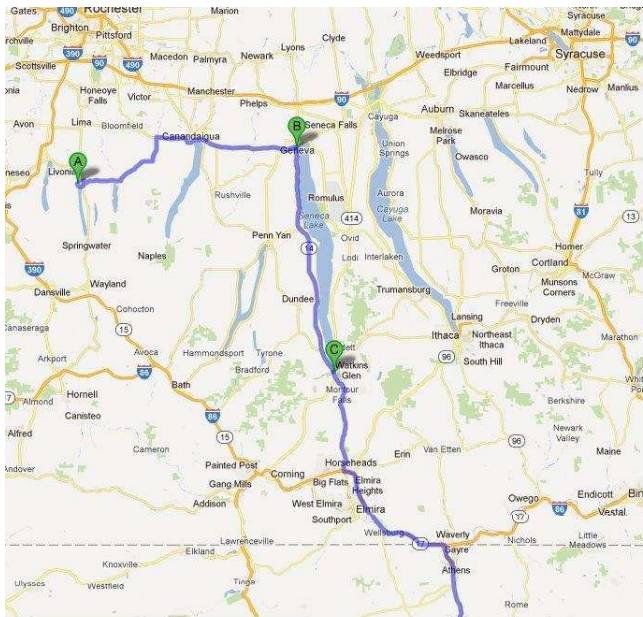
Stop D, 6:00PM – ECMC will treat you to a steak/chicken BBQ dinner at “The Ranch” in Hemlock, NY. The Ranch is the home of Al Rizzo and Dan Marty, who are close friends of the club and have donated their space for us to host our Saturday night dinner and arrival party. In addition to bed space for the night, this large farmhouse and finished barn in the rolling countryside of the finger lakes region features a swimming pool, hot tub, billiards table, fully-stocked bar and a large “playroom” for those that enjoy reclining in a “leather hammock” for a spell. (wink, wink!) Don’t over-pack – linens and towels are provided. Bed space will be assigned on a ‘first register, first served’ basis. There are some sleeping bags for any overflow and space in the TV lounge for sleeping. Some of the Rochester Rams M/C will come down and party with us!

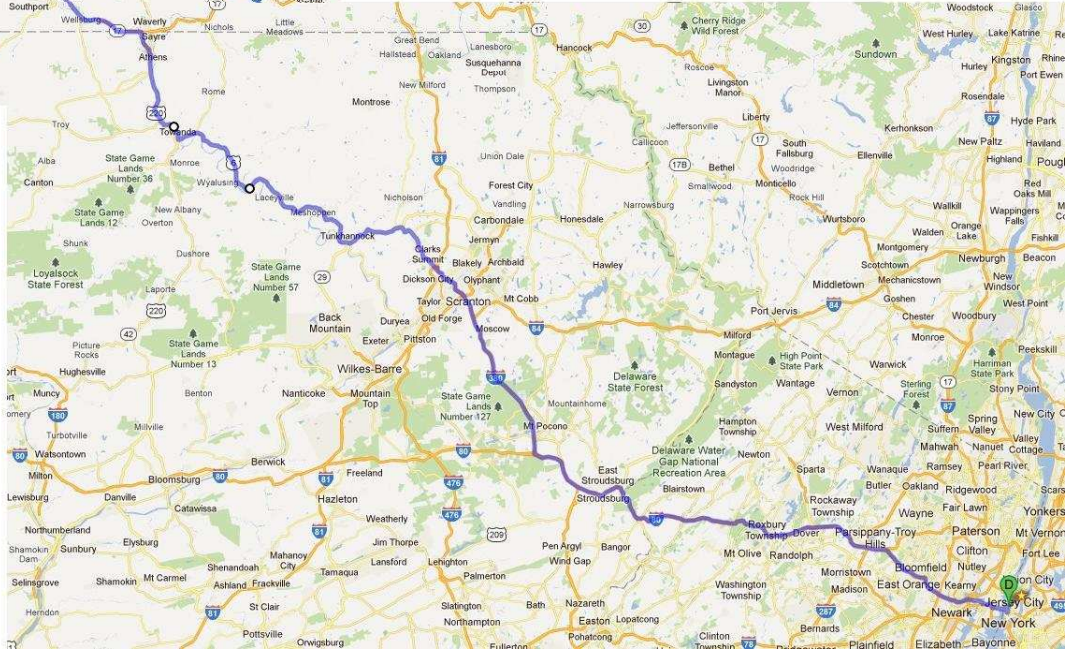
For example, if you will meet up with us at the Citgo, have lunch in Hancock, then leave – tick “Stop B and Stop C”, but not A or D.



**Please read these instructions**

Here is our planned ride, returning to Ty's in New York City on Sunday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>. We understand that not everyone will want to come all the way back to the city and may want to split off from the group.

Please tick the boxes “” below to indicate at which stops you will still be with us. Please an “X” on the route of where you intend to leave the group, if that is your intention.



Starting point A, 12 o'clock Noon – Be prepared to leave promptly at noon. We shall ride through some rolling countryside, passing a few towns, villages and some finger lakes themselves, including Honeoye Lake, Canandaigua Lake and riding alongside the entire length of Seneca Lake. We shall make gas stops and breaks as deemed necessary by the group. When we come into Geneva, NY there are several traffic lights and we may be split up.

Stop B, 1PM – We have established a re-group point (if needed) on Route 14 South, just as you leave the 5 & 20. The exit for Route 14 is clearly marked and is just before the bridge that goes over the 5 & 20. Our re-group shall be on the right side of the road once on Route 14 South.

Stop C, 2PM – Photo Op at Watkin's Glen State Park in the car park by the waterfall! Gas up at the Valero and grab a snack/lunch at the Burger King or the Great Escape Ice Cream Shop. We will depart at 2:30PM sharp. Note: We will make fuel/food stops as requested by the group from this point forward, we expect a number of New Jersey/Pennsylvania riders to leave our group between Stop C and D.

Stop D, roughly 7:30PM – We arrive at Ty's Bar in New York City for a celebratory beer or two!
