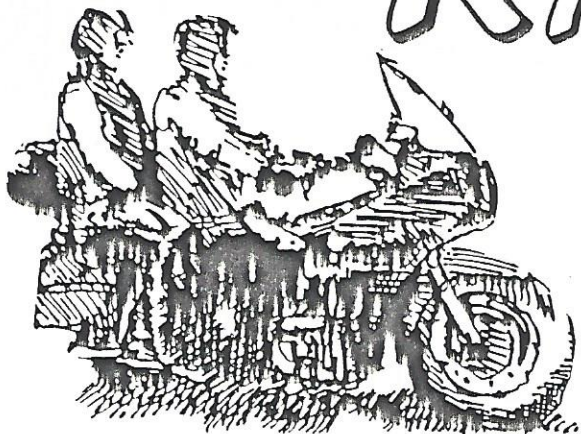


# Northeast RIDING



## Enjoy Northeast RIDING Tours "Cape Cod Discovery"

WELCOME to Northeast RIDING Tours "Cape Cod Discovery." Available weekends are May 11-13, June 8-10, July 6-8, August 3-5, and September 7-9. Enrollment on each tour is limited to 12 couples. Reservations are required at least eight weeks prior to the tour date.

A \$50 deposit will hold your reservation and the balance is due 30 days before departure.

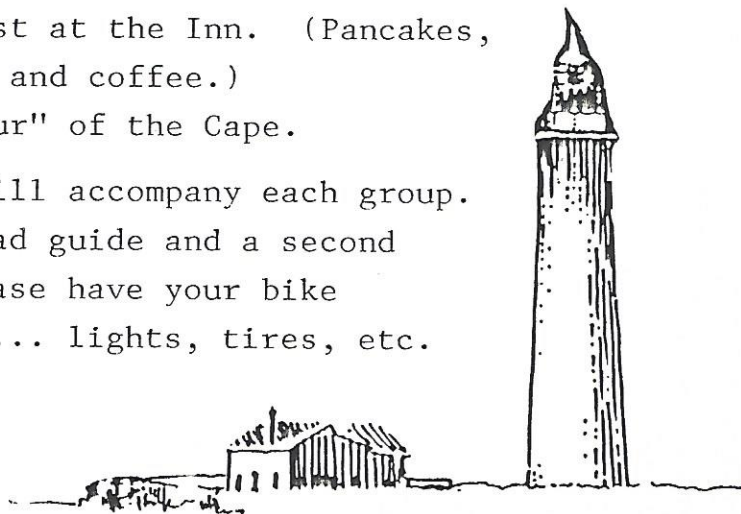
COST OF THE CAPE COD TOUR: The three-day weekend costs only \$225 per couple (!) for a room with a private bath, or \$195 per couple for a shared bath. (The bath is shared by no more than two rooms.)

### CAPE COD TOUR INCLUDES:

- [ ] 2 nights at the historic Old Sea Pines Inn.
- [ ] Friday lunch at Campanini's of Rhode Island.
- [ ] Cocktail hour Friday evening at the Inn.
- [ ] Saturday Country Breakfast at the Inn. (Bacon, sausage, eggs, toast, juice, and coffee.)
- [ ] Saturday evening Sea Food Buffet at the Inn.
- [ ] Sunday Country Breakfast at the Inn. (Pancakes, bacon, sausage, juice, and coffee.)
- [ ] Escorted "Insiders Tour" of the Cape.

TOUR GUIDES: Two tour guides will accompany each group. There will be an experienced lead guide and a second back-up vehicle following. Please have your bike safety-checked before departure... lights, tires, etc.

ITINERARY: Tours will assemble 9:30 am Friday morning at the Route 66 Truck Stop in Southington, Connecticut (Exit 27 I-84 Eastbound -- Exit 28 I-84 Westbound) and will depart promptly at 10 am. This location will allow us to fill our tanks and empty our bladders. (There's also a Dunkin Donut... our treat.) We'll send you directions prior to the departure date in case you miss us in Southington.

Just prior to the departure, when all tour participants have assembled, there will be a short briefing on group riding rules, planned stops, and the riding route to Cape Cod.

Approximately two hours and fifteen minutes from Southington we'll stop for lunch at Campanini's Restaurant in Rhode Island. It's a lovely pub with a 1600's atmosphere. Only non-alcoholic beverages will be served. Estimated time of arrival at the Inn is 4 pm. Total riding time at a leisurely pace and allowing for holiday traffic is about four and a half hours from the starting point.

Our hosts at the Inn will show you to your room and give you plenty of time to unpack and relax before gathering with the group for cocktails in the large sun-filled room off the porch.

Strike out on your own for dinner Friday evening. There are many fine restaurants in the immediate area, some of which are just a short walk away. You will find a list of eating places and prices available to choose from, or you may elect to stay at the Old Sea Pines Inn for dinner.

Saturday morning, after a filling country breakfast, we'll be off to an early start for an exciting tour of the Cape. We'll visit many of the places that are typically Cape Cod plus many out of the way attractions that ordinary tourists often miss. We'll return to the Inn about 3 pm to give you time to rest, shower, and get ready for dinner (seafood and chicken buffet) in the Old Sea Pines Inn dining room.

Saturday evening you can choose to relax and visit with the others in the group or go out for a night on the town... Provincetown! The Inn has a large, lovely parlor with a stone fireplace and the furniture arranged to encourage conversations.

Weather permitting, a night ride for ice cream may be in order.

After a hearty breakfast Sunday morning, you can take a short walk from the Inn to the beach and enjoy Cape Cod Bay or just sit and relax. About 10 am we'll take a final excursion and prepare for the ride home.

Cape Cod offers many unspoiled beaches, quaint New England villages, gift shops, galleries, the hustle and bustle of Provincetown, and the quiet beauty of sea-side walks or a sunset over the bay. There are endless roads of scenic beauty to ride. We think you'll be glad you came along.
