The proposed amendment would change the constitution to read:

## ARTICLE IV - Officers and Directors

### 3. Duties of Officers:

- b. The Vice President shall serve in the absence of the President. *He shall plan all club non-biking activities.*
- c. The Road Captain shall plan all club *rides and biking activities*. He shall enforce all rules of club riding.

## 1993 Bylaws

(And 1994 Suggested Changes)

(Automatic Change: Replace the number 1993 with 1994)

### Statement of Purpose:

Riders Motorcycle Club, Boston, is a social, fraternal organization for gay men who enjoy the activity of motorcycle riding.

### Bylaw #1. Membership Criteria/Types of Membership:

#### A. Full Membership:

Open to any gay adult male who lives in New England and who owns and rides a motorcycle and has paid his annual dues. Colors (Large Patch) and Membership Cards and Pins may be procured by Full Members. Full Members have the right to hold office and to vote on club issues. [Suggested change: Change highlighted section to "who has and rides"]

#### B. Associate Membership:

Open to any former Full Member who has moved out of the New England area and who has paid his annual dues. Associate Members may procure an Associates' Patch (Small Size), and a newsletter. They may not hold office nor vote on club issues.

[Suggested change: Change Section B to: "Open to any former Full Member who is no longer able to fully participate in the life of the Club. Associate Members may procure an Associates' Patch (Small Size), and newsletter. They may not hold office nor vote on Club issues.]

#### C. Honorary Membership:

Open to any person, who in the opinion of the membership, has rendered substantial service to the club. This award is voted on by the membership upon nomination by the Captain of the club. Honorary Members are not entitled to wear any of the club insignia, nor do they have the right to vote on club issues.

#### D. Membership Resiliation:

There are no restrictions on Members of Riders M.C. being members of another motorcycle club, except that Officers of Riders M.C. may not hold office in another motorcycle club during their term of office in Riders M.C.

#### E. Termination of Membership:

Any Member who abuses club property, consistently fails in an un-safe manner, refuses to fulfill financial obligations to the club, engages in behavior that brings disrepute to the club, may be terminated from membership in the club by a majority vote of the elected Officers.

### Bylaw #2. Meetings for 1993:

#### A. Number of Meetings:

During 1993 meetings shall be held twice a month from April-October, and once a month November-March.

#### B. Types of Meetings:

One meeting a month must be a business meeting. The second meeting in the months of April-October shall be a social meeting.

#### C. Annual Meeting of Riders M.C.:

The Annual Business Meeting of Riders M.C. shall be conducted at the February business meeting. The Annual Bylaws and Club Calendar shall be adopted at this meeting.

#### D. Days of Meetings:

The business meeting of each month shall be on the second Thursday of each month at 8:00 PM at the published location. The social meeting of the months of April-October shall be during the fourth week of each month as published in the newsletter.

### Bylaw #3. Dues:

A. Annual dues, as voted upon by the Full Membership of the Club at the November business meeting must be paid by December 31, for the upcoming riding year.

B. In order to vote in the Election of Officers at the Holiday/Awards Party, dues for the upcoming year must be paid by the date of Section.

### Bylaw #4. Club Properties:

Riders M.C. has Properties that fall into two categories: Movable and Non-Movable. The Movable Properties are the T-Shirts, Patches, and other Club paraphernalia that are available for purchase by the Membership. The cost of these items is borne by those who purchase them. The Non-Movable Properties are those things the Club buys for use by Members. This includes, but is not limited to, the trailer, ice chests, maps, and other such things that benefit the Club. Any member may make use of Club Property with proper notification to the Quartermaster.

### Bylaw #5. Officers for 1993:

A. Riders M.C. has a small group of Officers whose duty is to facilitate the life of the Club. Their function is to propose ideas for adoption by Membership, and upon adoption by the Membership, to carry out the decisions of the membership. In case of emergency, the Captain of the Club, upon consultation with an Officer may make decisions on behalf of the Club when there is not time to consult the Membership. All such decisions shall be reported to the Membership at the next meeting of the Club.

ROAD CAPTAIN: Serves as one who plans and executes activities and runs. Responsible for planning and making arrangements on behalf of club for any run/activity he is leading. Keeps record of attendance and writes report on activity he leads and gives the same to the Scribe for inclusion in the newsletter. Performs other such tasks as are ordinarily associated with the office of a committee chairperson in similar clubs.

APPOINTED OFFICERS:

The Captain, with the endorsement of the club, appoints the following officers:

QUARTERMASTER: Reports to the Treasurer and is responsible for the non-moveable (non-saleable) assets of the club, such as the trailer, radios, etc. Provides an annual inventory of the same to the Treasurer.

PUBLIC RELATIONS OFFICER: Reports to the Captain and is responsible for advertising the existence of the club, recruitment of new members, orientation of new members. Represents the club as designated to community groups.

THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Executive Committee of Riders M.C. is composed of the elected officers of the club. The committee is responsible for planning and implementing the club approved By Laws and Calendar of the year. The Committee oversees the good order and smooth running of the club. The Committee can make decisions on behalf of the club if necessary requires it to do so and a decision cannot wait until the next scheduled business meeting. All such decisions shall be reported to the club at the next scheduled business meeting. The Committee performs other such tasks as are ordinarily associated with a board of directors of similar clubs.

Bylaw #6. Rules of the Road for 1993.

A The Club trailer is available on a twelve month basis for use by the Club and its Members. Members may not use the trailer for any extended period of time for personal use. The trailer is a support vehicle for Club runs and an emergency vehicle for Members, when they have need of a tow. Towing is available only for Full Members with bikes that are registered with the Club. A fee to cover the cost of gas & related expenses (tolls) will be paid by the Member being towed to the tower. The Quartermaster is responsible for the storage, maintenance, and supervision of the trailer.

B. Chain of Command:

1. Captain
2. Secretary/Scribe
3. Treasurer
4. Safety Officer
5. Road Captains

C. JOB DESCRIPTION OF OFFICERS FOR 1994

ELECTED OFFICERS:

CAPTAIN: Serves as president of the club. Presides at meetings, appoints committees as needed, represents the club to community group coordinates the life of the club, appoints Quartermaster and Public Relations Officer, performs other such tasks as are ordinarily associated with the office of president in similar clubs.

SECRETARY: Serves as recording and corresponding secretary of the club. Keeps minutes of meetings, accurate membership list, maintains archives of club. Fills in for Captain in case of absence or incapacity. Publishes monthly newsletter, arranges for publication of club materials (e.g. Safety Manual, recruitment brochures, etc.) Performs other such tasks as are ordinarily associated with the office of secretary in similar clubs.

TREASURER: Serves as fiscal officer for the club. Keeps accurate record of the assets and liabilities of the club. Reports to club on financial affairs of the club. Develops budgets, pays bills, reimburses for approved expenses. Responsible for filing any necessary federal or state tax returns. Purchases club materials as approved (e.g. patches, pins, equipment). Supervises the Quartermaster, performs other such tasks as are ordinarily associated with the office of treasurer in similar clubs.

SAFETY OFFICER: Serves as supervisor of safety of club activities and runs. Develops the annual Safety Manual. Keeps members abreast of current safety issues relative to motorcycling. Writes a safety oriented column for the monthly newsletter. Performs other such tasks as are ordinarily associated with the office of safety supervisor/instructor in similar clubs.

B. While dedicated to safe riding, Riders M.C. recognizes the rights of individual Riders, within the limits of the law, to make use of or not make use of a helmet or other safety device. When riding as a group, Riders M.C. will observe the laws of the jurisdiction in which the group finds itself.

C. Riders M.C. exists for Club activities and is not a fund raising organization. With the approval of the Membership, interested Members, with the assistance of the Club, may run fund raisers for worthy causes. Any such fund raisers would be approved at a business meeting and only if Members have personally committed themselves to do the work involved.

D. A quorum for the Annual Business Meeting and business meetings during 1993 shall be 10% of Full Members present and voting. The Secretary and Treasurer will make monthly updates and certify the number of Full Members before each monthly business meeting.

E. Terms of Officers for Officers of Riders M.C. shall be January 1-December 31. Voting for Officers shall be in a two stage process: nominations in October-November, and voting by written ballot and installing of Officers shall be held at the annual Christmas Holiday Celebration of the Club.

(Suggested Change: Add to end of paragraph: "In July, the Captain, with the approval of the Officers, will appoint a Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee will publish a Slate of Candidates in the October newsletter. Additional nominations from the Membership at large will be taken at the October and November business meetings. Ballots and Candidates' Statements will be published in the December newsletter.")

F. A Membership Year shall run from January 1-December 31. During that period of time a Full Member is entitled to all rights and privileges of membership including active and passive votes.

G. For all activities that require reservations to be paid in advance, a Registration Form and payment of Activity Fee (Run Fee) shall be made by those wishing to participate at least two weeks in advance of the activity. Members who wish to participate after the deadline for preregistration has passed may do so, but with the understanding that the Club cannot guarantee accommodation at the same rate or quality as has been arranged by preregistration. Pre-registration funds may be returned to a Member who cannot attend an event for which he has paid, provided that by doing so no cost is incurred by the Club or by those participating in the run.

H. An Annual Directory of phone numbers and address of Members shall be published and made available to all Members. Members who wish their phone number

and address published in the Directory may indicate this on their annual Membership Application and only these names will be listed in the Directory.

I. Decisions requiring a vote of the Membership shall be made at the

monthly business meeting. Notice of decisions to be made shall be published in the newsletter of the month in which the decision is to be made. A quorum having been established at the meeting, a simple majority of Full Members present and voting is sufficient for reaching a decision.

J. Mileage Contest for 1993: Members who wish to participate may have their odometer read by an Officer on or after the April business meeting. Final odometer reading must be read by an Officer before or at the October social meeting.

Bylaw #7: Activities for 1993:

Activities for 1993 shall be voted on by the Membership at the Annual Business Meeting in February and shall be published in an Annual Calendar. Updates to the activities will be published in the monthly newsletter and posted on a Monthly Calendar in Rider's display case in the Ramrod.

Bylaw #8: Change/Amend/Delete/Add to Bylaws.

A. The annual Bylaws shall be adopted at the Annual Business Meeting of each year. Once adopted the Bylaws for a given year cannot be altered in any way until the next February business meeting.

B. Bylaws may be added during the course of the year in order to address a specific issue. Any new Bylaw that is to be made outside the Annual Business Meeting

shall be published in the newsletter for the month in which the proposed Bylaw is to be voted upon. Voting on new Bylaws takes place at the monthly business meeting.
