T-shirt fundraiser project, goal is to be available by June 2022.

Update: Peter Matheson Gay (Referred by Erik R.) is familiar with this type of project and has offered his assistance. Peter's contact information Cell # 917.498.2235 email <u>peter.m.gay@gmail.com</u> Update Peter G. presented 3 different t-shirt designs to be used for our T-shirt fundraising efforts. Our club members suggested having the shirts on hand to sell vs online sales. The original goal was to have these available for Folsom Street East event if we do a tent. Due to gang related issues #2 design was axed. A favorable idea mentioned is design #1 on the back of the shirt, and design #3 on the left breast. In order to keep the cost down by doing white/grey print (1-2 color) on a black shirt. Another idea was to sell @ bars. Update: Peter G. to create a mock-up and develop cost per shirt. ECMC agreed #1 to be on the back of shirt and #3 to be left breast/centered/ or left sleeve. Kudos!

Motion: As previously decided, the Empire City MC t-shirt will be printed on black cotton and will feature a white design appearing on the front (an Empire City MC word mark), and another white design on the back (motorcycle with NY city skyline). The Committee has sourced a printing vendor who has provided us with an estimate to produce our shirts. Depending on the final size allotments, the budget needed to cover the printing and shipping of 100 t-shirts is estimated not to exceed \$900. At this price, each shirt costs \$9. This cost breakdown will give ample room if the club wants to sell the t-shirts as a charitable fundraiser. The following is the proposed t-shirt sizing breakdown of the printing order:
