Fun-filled 'La Cage' lives up to its fanfare

YES, IT is. It really is. La Cage aux Folles is a musical sufficient in itself to make your forget any French movie of a similar name. It opened at the Palace Theater last night, it has music and lyrics by Jerry Herman and a book by Harvey Fierstein, a knock-out performance by George Hearn, and it is totally every-

thing - all almost to-

thing — all almost totally everything — you
have ever heard about it.

fanfare of advance welcome that they almost

Just 10 years ago Jean Poiret wrote the original Poiret wrote the original play, and later it became a highly original film. It portrayed homosexuality as a legitimate lifestyle. It was a play—and then a film—simply about love.

That is part of the reason why La Cage is so moving. Fierstein—a a sometime drag queen

sometime drag queen himself—has somewhat deepened the original Poiret, chiefly by making it a story about personal acceptance and human dignity.

But that is not the only cause for La Cage to be a

hit. Underpinning and, at times, overriding the story, or even more the theme, are Jerry Her-man's music and lyrics. This is his best musical yet — happier, more as-sertive, more bouyant e, more bou Hello Dolly!


And with that kind of music. That kind of breezy, swingy Broad-way music that you thought had, at least briefly, from style. disappeared
