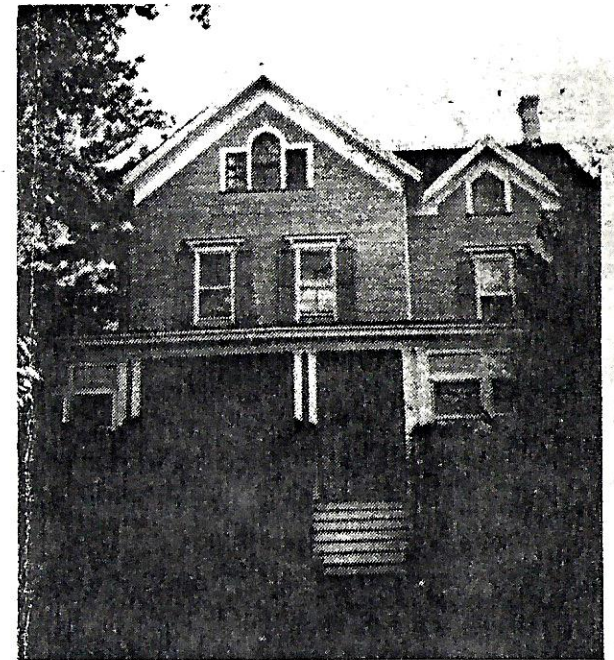

This swing hangs on the porch of a circa 1872 - 16-room Victorian house, sitting on a half-acre, private, park-like setting in Roselle, New Jersey.

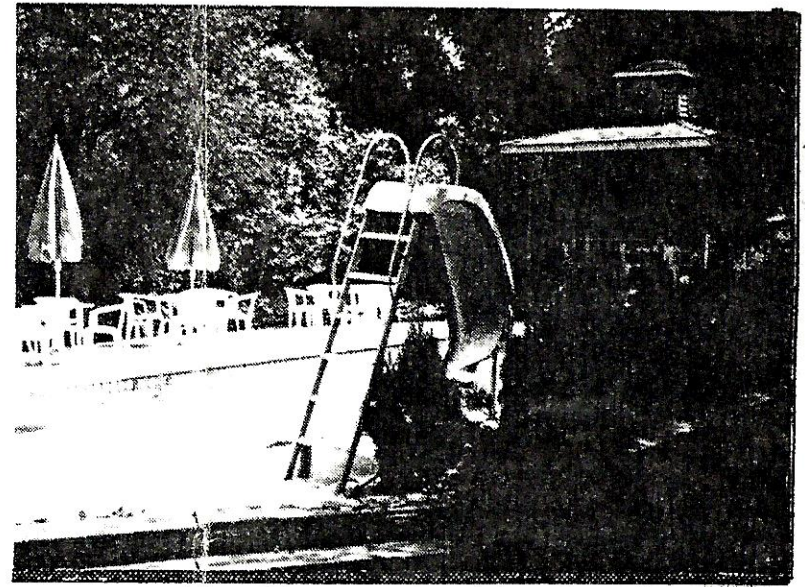


The house, which is owned and operated by gay leathermen who are TRUST members, features a hot tub, and in the Summer, an in-ground heated pool, barbecue, and dining gazebo complete the atmosphere. The house also sports three fireplaces, three-and-a-half baths, and both single and double occupancy rooms.

Guests of the house are served a continental breakfast every morning in the over-sized kitchen, with a choice of muffins, cereals, teas and coffees. Coffee and tea are always available at any time of the day or night.

To help your stay with us be as pleasant as possible, our houseboy will see to your comfort, and the house washer and dryer are available for your use. We also offer car service into New York City, whether for bar hopping or serious shopping.

Our rooms are quite reasonable priced at just \$59 per night, and we do not have a hard and fast check-in or check-out time like "business first" hotels - yet one more reason to choose a bed-and-breakfast rather than a hotel. Yet, like a hotel, we offer the convenience of
