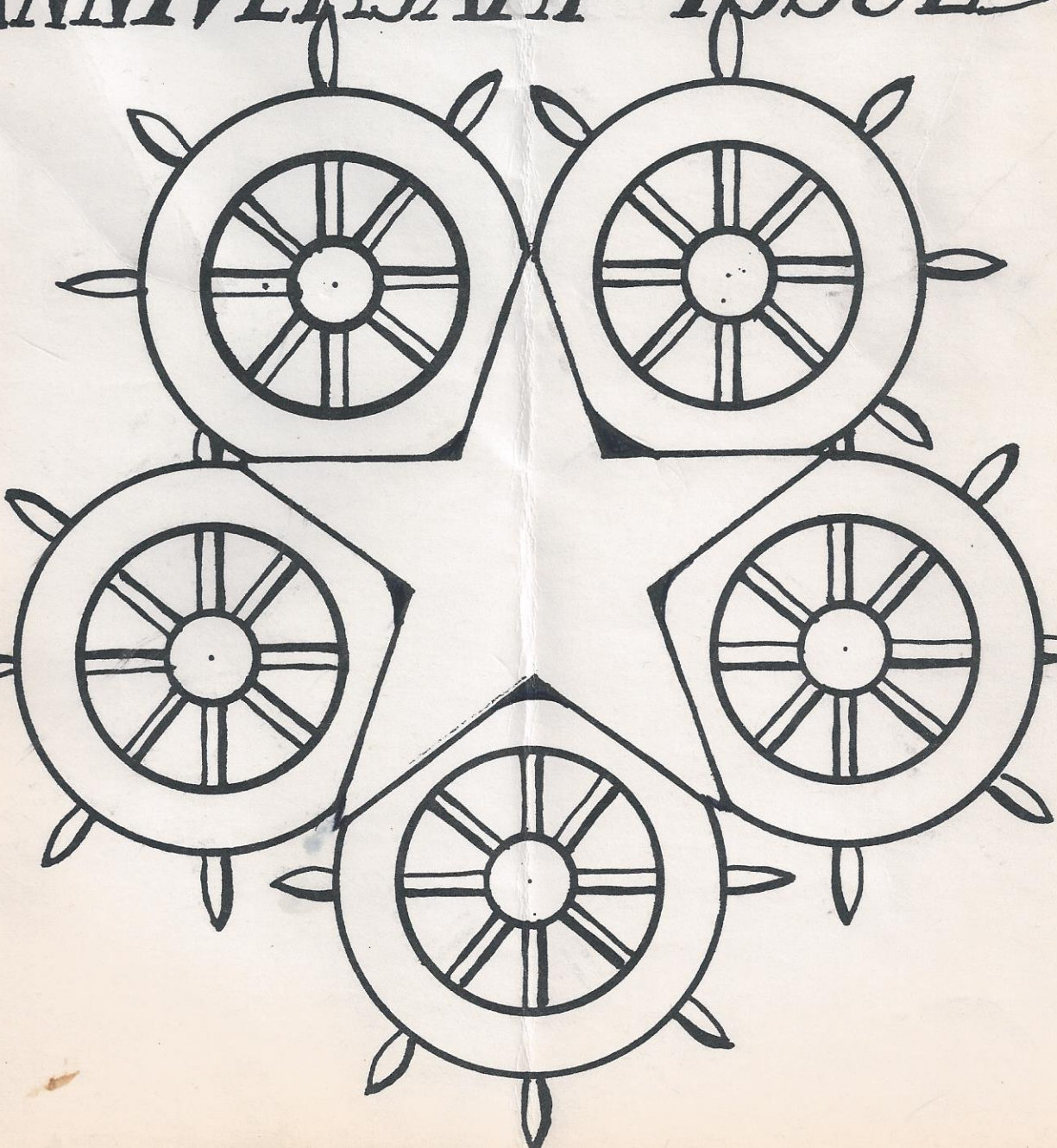

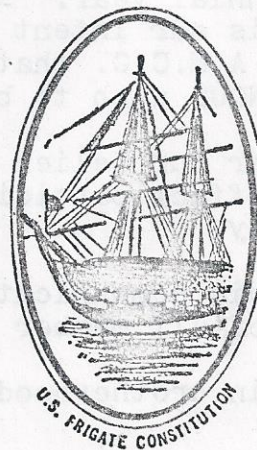

OFFICERS OF THE A.M.C.C.

September 22, 1975

Gentlemen:

It is the intent of this communication to assist the A.M.C.C. in their forthcoming and difficult decision relative to the announcement by the BUCKS M.C. that they fully intend to proceed with "1776 III", in July 1976, in Bucks County, Pa.

At ENTRE-NOUS meeting of September 7, 1975, a motion was introduced and passed, that:

- (a) ENTRE-NOUS fully and completely supports the decision of the BUCKS M.C. to hold their run during 1976.
- (b) ENTRE-NOUS also fully intends to hold "DAYS OF EQUINOX" in March 1976, in Boston, Mass., for the same basic reason as the BUCKS M.C.
- (c) That the A.M.C.C. be notified as soon as possible of our intention.

The motion, duly seconded, was carried by a vote of 35 "FOR" and 1 "OPPOSED".

The cities of Philadelphia and Boston, as you are well aware, were extremely instrumental in the American Revolution. Historically we are immensely proud of our heritage. Both cities have a great deal to offer. The brotherhood which succeeded in accomplishing the Revolution bears similarity to the bonds of brotherhood which exist within the A.M.C.C.

We are both intent upon displaying those treasures to which we are endeared to the member clubs as well as others during the Bicentennial year. Neither club is requesting sanction. Rather, it is our intent to be excepted from the stringent idea of the A.M.C.C. that NO runs be held during 1976. Neither does ENTRE-NOUS wish to be penalized for it's action.

It is further our belief that neither of these two runs will in any way affect participation in the Bicentennial Run in Atlantic City.

A copy of this communication has been forwarded to the Presidents of all member clubs of the A.M.C.C.
