SPEARHEAD

AN AFFILIATION - A BROTHERHOOD - A CLUB

Spearhead was founded in Toronto on March 15, 1970, by a small group of men during one of the most contentious times of change in Canadian Gay History.

The affiliation is best described in the words of our first president Alan MacGowan:

“The SPEARHEAD is an affiliation of fellows who wish to be recognized with pride, and who appreciate the value and privilege of belonging to a group of similar fellows who are all “brothers under the skin”. A fellowship for the purpose of identifying one another and knowing that you “belong”.

“The affiliation is not an S&M group, not a bike group, not a leather group, not a western-denim group, or any such group. It is all of these groups combined! It is a masculine group that is interested in meeting and associating with other masculine individuals for the purpose of Mutual Identification, Association, and Personal Gratification.

“It holds no personal limitations, no geographic limitations, no specific limitations, other than its Masculinity, Masculine Personality, and Mutual Masculine Gratification. The Spearhead is limited only to those individuals who believe in and are proud to be associated with an organization maintaining these Principles”.

This makes Spearhead to oldest continuously operating gay organization in Canada.

Phalia, our bi-monthly publication (first issue June 1970) has produced ever since, now making it the second oldest gay periodical in North America. Currently Phalia is produced electronically, with a few printed copies for archival purposes and for the few members that don't have email. As well, the most recent issues are available on Spearhead's website www.spearheadtoronto.com.

During this period of time, harassment and entrapment were commonplace, and even entering a gay bar was dangerous, so the types of acceptance we take for granted today was nowhere to be seen at the time of our founding, and MacGowan's words show a self-assurance that was pretty rare for the time. It's important to remember, that homosexuality was only decriminalized in Canada in 1969.

Right from the beginning there was international outreach to other likeminded affiliations and there quickly developed a bond of friendship between us with active participation in each other's get-togethers.

From very start the idea of a “Club Run” was on the minds of Spearhead members, and in 1970 the first Spearhead “In-Town” run was held over the Labour Day weekend, with events being held, mostly in Toronto. In 1972 the organizers decided to hold the event over the Dominion Day (now Canada Day) weekend. This was the only run to be held in the summer as it was moved back to Labour Day weekend in 1973. One result from this “experiment” was that to replace the popular success of the Rodeo, Spearhead booked the first ever boat cruise for men only.

In 1978 organizers decided to try an “Out-Of-Town” run and it remained an out of town run until the final run in 2010. There was plans for another “In-Town” run in 20__ but was cancelled due to lack of participants.

The announcement for the first run, that appeared in Phalia, is reprinted on the below.

The hog call is out to all members (and friends) in Toronto, Montreal, Detroit, Chicago, New York, Dallas, San Francisco, Boston, Vancouver, Washington, etc.

Miss the rest . . . but don't miss this one!

Four days of OFFICIAL EVENTS are already planned to keep you hopping; and if that's not enough, there's sure to be some UNofficial ones just for the lassoing . . . "ranch favourites" like: Chain-Climbing, Leather-Cleaning, Thong-Braiding, 3-Legged Bronco Breaking, and Bare-Back Ballroom Dancing.

The "ROUND-UP" fee is \$20.00 per head, with a chance to have all or part refunded to you, just for reserving early. Reservations post-marked August 13 or earlier. will be entered into a draw. The first members' name selected receives a \$20.00 refund. The second name selected receives a \$10.00 Refund. All others are received a "Special Bonus". The drawing to take place at the banquet on Sept. 5.

ALL RESERVATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY AUGUST 20 AND MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY CHECK OR MONEY ORDER IN FULL. (A Courier check and fully addressed envelope are enclosed for your convenience in replying. Do it now!)

So, get the fall duds out of the bunk-house, shine up the Spurs, and get ready for "ROUND-UP" of the year!

Mail in your reservation form and fee, right now!

IMPORTANT: "Check-in" 9:00 p.m. Friday, Sept. 4, and 9:00 a.m. Saturday, Sept. 5 (with breakfast)

These four-day events were jam packed with activities beginning first thing in the morning and continuing well into the night including dances, auctions, treasure hunts, theatrical events, with plenty of food and (lots and lots) of cocktails.

Each year, the Round-Ups had a different theme:

1970 – Corral; 1971 – Rodeo; 1972 – A Mid-Summer Round Up; 1973 – Around The World; 1974 – Early Days of the Canadian West; 1975 – Construction; 1976 – Olympiad 76; 1977 – Trading Post; 1978 – Bush It; 1979 – Klondike Days; 1980 – Gladiator; 1981 – Call o'the Wild; 1982 – (No Theme); 1983 – North 40; 1984 – Boot Camp; 1985 – Did It In The Woods; 1986 – Bear Theme, Hollow Log Haven; 1987 – Masquerade; 1989 – Spearhead In Space; 1990 – HMCS Spearhead; 1991 – Escape To Cellblock 21; 1992 – Cum Home For The Holidays—Xmas Theme; 1993 – What's In Those Overalls; 1994 – Nites of the Roundtable; 1995 – Lucky In Leather 25th Anniversary; 1996 – Men At Work; 1997 – Rumble In The Jungle; 1998 – Platoon

98; 1999 – Behind The Mask; 2000 – Leathermen and Lumberjacks; 2001 – Superheroes and Villains; 2002 – Locker Room – A Salute To Sports; 2003 – Harness Your Fantasy; 2004 – Rawhide; 2005 – Coming Together; 2006 – Construction; 2007 – Under The Big Top; 2008 – Leather Denim Pride; 2009 – An Officer and a Leatherman; 2010 – Return To Oz.

As is obvious from a lot of the themes there was a great deal of wit involved. However, an application for the 1975 Round-Up perhaps underscores some of the caution we (as a broader community) felt was necessary at the time in stating that “Note: only 150 applications will be considered.”

In addition to the runs, there were series of very popular events including Fantasy Ball, the Anniversary Dinner, and the Canada Day Boat Cruise just to name a few signature social events.

The one thing Spearhead is known for is its philanthropic activities. Beginning in 1971 and continuing to this day Spearhead has been raising money for the community with our annual events such as:

- Our annual Toys-For-Tots event held at various locations in the Gay Village, raising cash and toys for service organizations tending to the needs of underprivileged and HIV + kids.
- The Easter and Thanksgiving fundraisers also held at various locations in the Gay Village raising cash and non-perishable food for the PWA Food Programs.
- In July our annual body-painting fundraiser, “Paint Yer Burger” a fundraiser for the current year’s charity of choice.
- In addition over the years we have had events such as Daddy’s Day BBQ held on Fathers Day, our Pride BBQ held during pride, a Hat Party fundraiser on the Black Eagle patio.

A short sampling of the recipients of our fundraising are: Children’s Aid Society; Toronto Star Fresh Air Fund; Dade County Fund and John Damien Defense Fund; Right to Privacy Committee and the Rainbow Society for the Deaf; the Rainbow Railroad; Casey House; Fife House; 519 Community Centre; Canadian Lesbian and Gay Archives; PWA Foundation; Camp Oasis; Lesbian and Gay Youth Counseling Hotline, The Teresa Group

It’s important to note that Spearhead is entirely revenue neutral – every dime that is collected for charity, goes to charity, all expenses to run the affiliation come from annual members fees.

Spearhead has been around for fifty years it is one of the few organizations in the community that offers a cross-generational perspective. It’s rather easy sometimes to forget that everything that we’ve gained in the last half-century could be wiped out with the stroke of a pen – it’s important to respect the voices of those who remember both how awful things were, but also to learn from the creativity involved in trying to make an awful situation a little more bearable.

Without the Spearheads of this world, thousands of dollars would not have been raised to help pay for the victories that we, as a wider community, have won. There are still battles to be fought, and rest assured, us guys in Spearhead aren’t going anywhere . . .

Following are copies of Letters Articles that appeared in Phalia, explaining what the Spearhead was, the President’s letter six months after formation, and a letter when the Spearhead was in their 18th year.

PRESIDENT MACGOWAN DESCRIBES THE NEW AFFILIATION IN PHALIA

A MESSAGE TO THE "OPEN MINDED"

It's time to call a spade, a spade. Not a "deuce". Not a "club". Particularly not a "club". Because that's what this message is all about! The fact that something that appears to be a club. . . isn't! And that something is "THE SPEARHEAD"!!!

Time and time again, the question comes up. "What in the hell is this "SPEARHEAD" outfit?" From in-towners. Out-of-towners. From friends. From strangers. The question is a familiar one. And one that now commands clarification.

Hopefully, the explanations that follow will end the mystery, once and for all.

First off, "THE SPEARHEAD" is comprised of people. Male people. Male people who prefer and respect the masculine look and personality regardless of what may or may not be hidden deep inside. Homophiles, who's tastes lean to, or are deeply enmeshed with Denim and Leather. Each interested in some, or many of the multitude of interests and other activities that can stem from these "basics".

A "SPEARHEAD" digs fellowship among his own kind. Some are active. Others, passive. Some are swingers. Others, the opposite. And undoubtedly, there are even some "way outs" well hidden in the growing numbers.

Some few, sport bikes. Most don't. Some, eventually will. Many may wish they could. But ALL. . . ALL have chosen to associate with the "SPEARHEAD" as a means of making their basic tastes known to anyone from anywhere who seeks the "likes of himself".

No, the "SPEARHEAD" is not a club. It is not a bike club. Is not an athletic club. Or any kind of club.

"Spearhead" is, however, a fellowship. . . a "fraternity", if you like. And those individuals who make up it's existence, hover no designs upon, suspicions towards, or jealousies against any recognized chartered club. . . or unchartered club. . . nor any individual member of those groups.

All masculine homophiles, compatible with the "basic" tastes and traits of the "SPEARHEAD" fraternity, are looked upon by a "SPEARHEAD" as "buddies under the skin". For mutual fellowship. Or mutual whatever. . .

The very foundation of the "SPEARHEAD" is unique in itself, and is fast becoming a welcome new dimension in Leather/Denim circles. And if the original pioneers of this new dimension feel any sense of pride whatsoever, the writer leaves it is well deserved.

All homophiles who wish "SPEARHEAD" identification, and DEMONSTRATE VISUALLY OR OTHERWISE THEIR WORTHINESS OF IT, are committed to no Rules, disciplines or restrictions of any kind. They are committed only "one to the other" as persons whose interests follow similar paths. From that point on, their personal performances are no one's business but their own.

We said we'd call a "Spade a Spade".

The Spearhead is now breaking out into a very wide geographical community. Nearly half of our 150 members are from outside the Toronto area - from east coast to west coast. We are very pleased that a branch of the Spearhead has been formed in Detroit, and there is a group in Montreal who hoped to develop a branch there soon. With a careful study of our guidelines and proposals, our whole format is not in any way a conflict

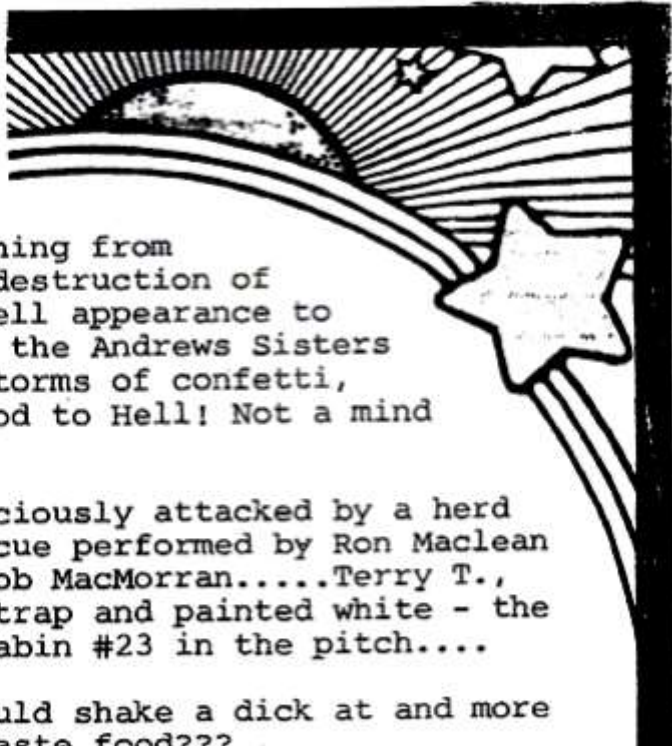

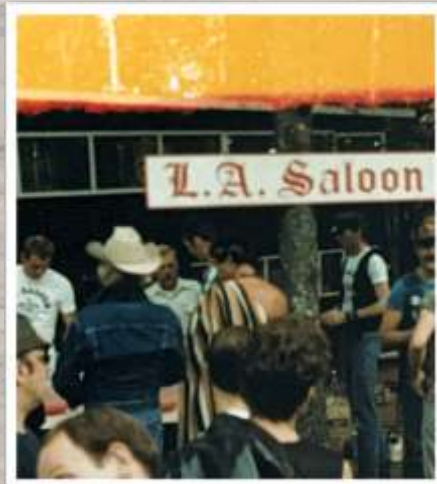
Round-Up facts appear elsewhere, but it's not who won that makes a run. What makes a run is "who"...and BUSH IT! had "who".... We thank you - the participants....

FANTASY BALL

The first fantasy ball was held at the 519 Community Center, on February 17th 1979, and it was a Costume Party. Tickets sold out early and many had to be turned away at the door. Fantasy Ball was born as a way to raise money for the installation of new trophy cases at the Barn, which at the time had become the home bar for Spearhead.

Spearhead in 1980 decided, after the success of the first Fantasy Ball to hold another one, the theme this year was "Thousand and One Nights" and as was quoted in Phalia magazine (Spearhead's Newsletter) "Fantasy Ball was a blast, one corner looked like a set for Cruising, one like Halloween at the Quest, there were more uniforms than a New York Party, and enough harnesses to make one think that Montgomery Leathers had made a fortune. The winner of the costume contest was no other than Miss Piggy. This event once again sold out.

Fantasy ball was Again at the 519 community Seven Community Center in 1980 one with the theme of peppermint twist and then 1982 the theme was Wild West. the last fantasy ball to be held at the 519 Community Center was in 1983 and the theme was "emperor's other ball", With a Viennese theme.

In 1995 Spearhead partnered with Crew on Church Street to produce a special version of fantasy ball in celebration of Spearhead's 25th Anniversary, entitled "The Black and Silver Ball".

In October of 1998 the next Fantasy Ball was held at the Opera House and marketed as "The Return of the Spearhead Fantasy Ball" with various pre-parties held at The Black Eagle, Bar 501, and Woody's. Spearhead also provided a shuttle bus service from Church Street to the Opera House on Queen Street East.

The next one was held in 2000 for Spearhead 30th Anniversary and was moved from October and to February.

After that fantasy ball continued at various locations including The Opera House the Black Eagle.

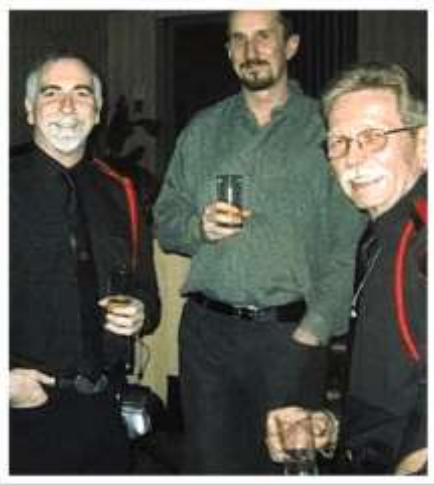
In July of 2002 a summer version was held called "Sweat" with 400 tickets being sold.

Regular participant Ernie Wesley once described the early parties as follows, "Fantasy Balls were originally costume parties held at the 519. Dalton once came as Minnie Ha Ha, complete with loin cloth and a feather in his hair. He also once came dressed as a ballerina in a tou-tou. I decided to come as a urinal once, that was a total disaster, people tried to pee and throw cigarettes butts into the front of it".

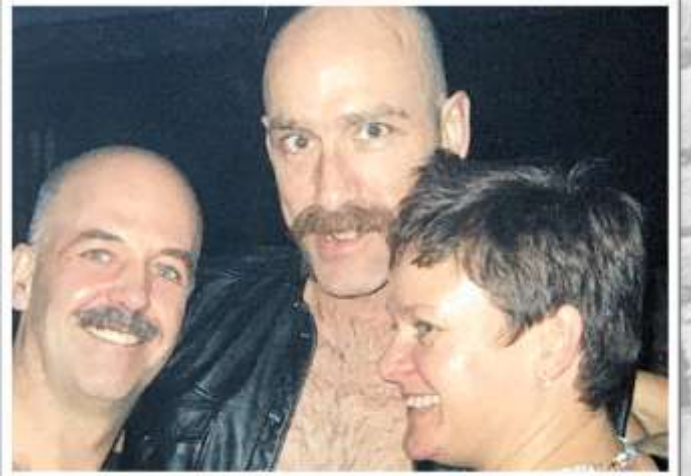
Fantasy Ball is now no longer produced.

SPEARHEAD ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATIONS

The 1st anniversary dinner of the new affiliation took place 1 year after the charter meeting from which the club grew.

It was a weekend of fun and business consisting of Friday evening registration upstairs at St. Charles, Saturday afternoon luncheon followed by the Spearhead's Annual General Meeting, and in the evening there was a formal dinner also held upstairs at the St. Charles. 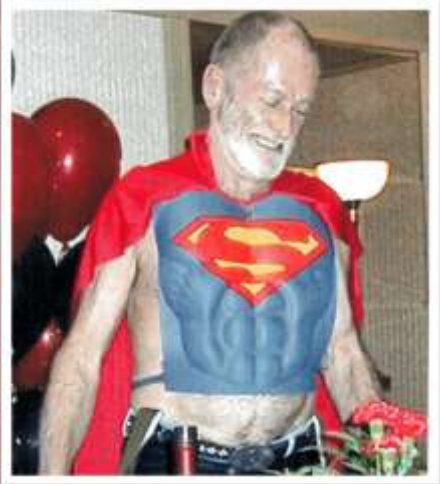

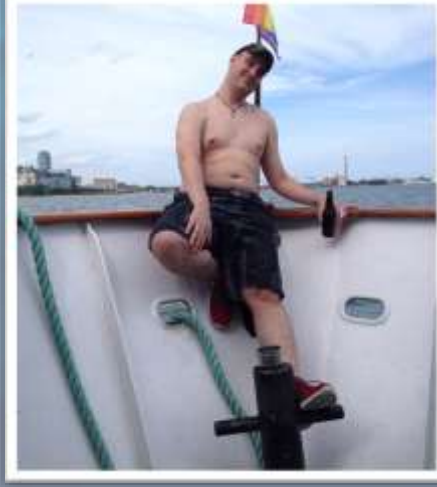
LEATHER ON THE LAKE SPEARHEAD'S ANNUAL BOAT CRUISES

Spearhead organized the first boat cruise in the summer of 1972. It was part of the Round-Up weekend that had been moved from Labour Day to the Dominion Day (Canada Day) as an event to replace the excursion to the Rodeo. Even though the boat cruise was a smashing success Spearhead could not repeat the event until two years later in 1974.

The cruise, that year, was held on Labor Day weekend as part of Round-Up which had been moved back to its traditional date. It was continually held as part of the Round-Up weekend until 1978 when Round-Up was changed from and In-Town Run to an Out-Of-Town Run. This change allowed Spearhead to move the cruise back to Dominion day (Canada Day) weekend when warmer weather could be expected.

It continues to be held on the Canada Day weekend ever since. For many years it was on the Mariposa Belle, then as the attendance became less it was moved to various boat but mainly and most recently has been on the Obsession III.

Paint-Yer-Burger was first held on June 1st 1977.

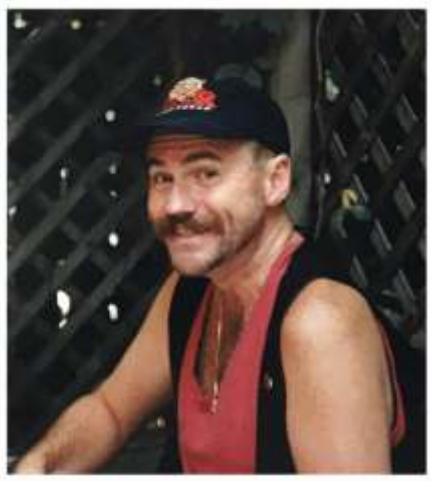

SPEARHEAD'S ANNUAL TOYS FOR TOTS

Early in Spearhead's history, it was suggested at one of their board meetings that members should bring a toy to the affiliations Christmas party in December. According to "Phalia" Spearhead's newsletter the "Bring A Toy for A Kid" was enthusiastically endorsed by the membership.

1975 Jack Mackness suggested that the "Bring A Toy for A Kid" slogan be changed to the "Toys for Tots" slogan used by motorcycle clubs across the USA.

In the early years of Toys for Tots there was a firm intention that all the toys collected be delivered during the same festive season, but as the event grew in popularity and Spearhead started receiving cash donations later, some was put over to the next year and also to purchase gift cards for distribution to the charities.

In the 1980s spearhead started collecting toys at bars to add to the ones collected at their own parties.

Today the "Toys for Tots" fundraisers are run in 4 locations in the village every November, Pegasus, Woody's, Black Eagle, and Flash.
