Well done for an event that was a last minute decision.

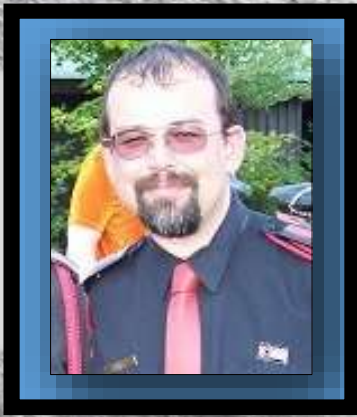

# A GUIDE TO PUPPY PLAY

What is puppy Play? Puppy play is when you act like a puppy or dog, get on all fours and act like a puppy/dog.

I will be going over some topics about puppy play, as well a short story on how I became a puppy and where I am in the community today. I will be going over some of the basics of puppy play.

## Gear

- There are many types of gear for pups, like harness, puppy mitts, knee pads,. The other thing is that you don't need gear to be a puppy to have fun. You can just go as yourself.

## Pup Hoods

- There are different types of Pup Hoods out there. Like from Northbound Leather and Mr. S Leather. Also, different styles of pup hoods too like Leather, Latex, Neoprene.

## Collars/leashes

There are many different types of collars and leashes out there. For collars the most common ones are chainmail and leather collars. The chainmail one is mostly worn as a daily collar and is not really meant for play. The leather ones are better for play because they are sturdier. There are lots of different leashes out there. There is a proper way to hold the leash, so your puppy does not get hurt.



## Trust

When it comes to this topic there is a lot. The person you are with, either if you are the Puppy or the Handler there has to be trust to make it work, If there is no trust it will not work. The most important part of trust is communication. Without communication by talking to one another the relationship of the puppy / handler / owner can fall apart and will be hard to regain trust.

## Rules

In Pup play there are rules that you have to follow. As the Pup or Handler who have set the rules If breaking one of the rules you have set can have a bad ending to the relationship. One I like the most is always be honest with you Pup/Handler, Sir, Master, Mistress. I also like to tell where I am going to let my Sir know I will be ok. Others have rules they set. It's always good to follow them.

## Pup Nights

Pup Nights are a place where all the Pups and Handlers come out to have a great time. At Pup Nights there is a space for us where we can be pups. There are mosh mats where the pup can get on all fours and play with the other pups, while their handler watches them to make sure that they are safe.

Also, at pup night there are rules to follow If any of the rules are broken you would have to leave pup night, plus if you did something really you could be banned from pup night.

## Pup Groups

There are many pup groups around the world. There are groups to meet new pups and handlers, Groups to help new pups to the community and groups to help pups who are alone and need help. Also, in some groups there are all title holders for their groups too.

## Gender/Sexual

Pup Play is for all genders, and it is not designated to one gender. Does not matter who you are, it's for everyone. As for been sexual it can be at times, but it is not always sexual. Most pups play to relieve stress and just want to have fun with other pups.

## Types of Pups/Handlers

There are many types of pups and handlers. For Pup There is 3 main types,

### Alpha Pup

The Alpha is the top dog of the pack, he/she can own a pup as well give other pups in the pack command to follow. The Alpha is like the Sir, Master, Dom

### Beta Pup.

The Beta pup is in the middle of the pack. The Beta follows the commands of the Alpha, as well The beta can also give some commands to the other pups in the pack. The Beta is like the switch.

### The Omega Pup

The Omega Pup is at the bottom of the pack. The Omega has to follow the commands of the Alpha and the Beta, The Omega does not have power to give commands to other pups. The Omega is like the bottom and as to follow all commands.



There are many different types of handlers, some like to go by Sir, Master. It is the handlers' job to make sure that the puppy is well looked after and safe.

### Headspace/Aftercare

Headspace is when the puppy is on the mats or at your home playing. It's a way to relieve stress, weight on your shoulder. Headspace is different for everyone, this is the same for the handler.

Aftercare is when pup night is over, and the puppy comes out of headspace. Everyone/puppy is different when they come out of headspace and need aftercare. Some pups can come out of headspace easily and others it hits them a bit harder. So, it's important to make sure Aftercare is the number one priority after pup night/pup play.

### My Small Story

So, I am going to tell you a bit about how I became a puppy. It All started when I lived in Kingston, Ontario in 2015. I went to see my friend for some kink play, then he told me about puppy play. I was like what is that? He said it is when you get on all fours and act like a dog and bark, I was like thats weird lol. He then pulled out his pup hood and let me try it on. Once he put it on me I instantly went on all fours acting like a puppy.

My friend said how do you like it? I was like OMG I love it, this is a great feeling, then he put a collar and leash on me, then we went for a walk. I was a puppy for the whole night till the next day I had to go home. When I got home I went online to find a pup hood hehe.

Going forward I went to my first pup night in 2016 in Toronto called the Black Eagle Kennel Klub. I was like omg this is going to be fun wags :) I had a great time at my first pup night.

Moving forward to now. I have been in the pup community for 6 years now. I still love it today. I still go to events to help my community and I have helped other pups just starting out as a pup in the community and I welcome them with big arms.

That is the short story on how I became a puppy. I hope that this little presentation helps you understand a little more on puppy play and the community.

# RECIPE CORNER

## SNACKS

### BLUE CHEESE BUFFALO CHICKEN BALLS

*For a quick snack or a party dish you can serve with fancy little toothpicks, these slightly spicy buffalo balls, packed with rich blue cheese, are just the ticket.*

**SERVES 4 TO 6 / PREP TIME: 10 MINUTES / COOK TIME: 18 MINUTES**

#### INGREDIENTS

- \* 1 pound free-range ground chicken
- \* 1 large free-range egg, lightly beaten
- \* 1 cup shredded organic mozzarella cheese
- \* 1/2 cup crumbled organic blue cheese
- \* 1/4 cup chopped celery 2 tablespoons water
- \* 1 teaspoon onion powder
- \* 1/2 teaspoon sea salt
- \* 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper
- \* Favorite Buffalo Sauce or Buffalo Sauce (recipe below)

#### DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 450°F
2. Line a baking pan with parchment paper.
3. In a large bowl, combine the chicken, egg, mozzarella and blue cheeses, celery, water, onion powder, salt, and pepper. Use your hands to mix the ingredients well.
4. Form the mixture into about 20 meatballs, placing them in the baking pan as you do.
5. Bake until the internal temperature reaches 165°F, about 18 minutes.
6. Meanwhile warm the buffalo sauce in a medium saucepan over low heat.
7. When the meatballs are done, toss them in the warm sauce and serve.

## SAUCES

### BUFFALO SAUCE

**SERVES 8 / PREP TIME: 5 MINUTES / COOK TIME: 5 MINUTES**

#### INGREDIENTS

- \* 2/3 cup hot pepper sauce (such as Frank's RedHot®)
- \* 1/2 cup cold unsalted butter
- \* 1 1/2 tablespoons white vinegar
- \* 1/4 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce
- \* 1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- \* 1/8 teaspoon garlic powder
- \* salt to taste

#### DIRECTIONS

1. Combine the hot sauce, butter, vinegar, Worcestershire sauce, cayenne pepper, garlic powder, and salt in a pot and place over medium heat.
2. Bring to a simmer while stirring with a whisk.
3. As soon as the liquid begins to bubble on the sides of the pot, remove from heat, stir with the whisk, and set aside for use.



## CHOWDER

### FISH CHOWDER

*Note: Served with thick home made bread or tea biscuits it makes a meal.*

#### INGREDIENTS

- \* 2 lbs. Haddock or Cod Fillets (1 kg)
- \* 1/2 lb. Salt Pork, diced (125 g)
- \* 3 Large Potatoes, diced
- \* 1 large Onion, diced
- \* 2 Cups Boiling Water (500 ml)
- \* 1 Tsp. Salt (5 ml)
- \* 1/4 Tsp. Pepper (1 ml)
- \* 3 Cups Milk (750 ml)
- \* 1 Cup Cream (250 ml)
- \* 1 Tbsp. Butter (15 ml)
- \* 1 Tbsp. Green Onions, chopper (15 ml)

#### DIRECTIONS

1. Sauté pork until crisp, add onion and sauté for another few minutes.
2. Add boiling water and potatoes and cook until potatoes are tender
3. Cut fish fillets in 2 - 3 inch pieces
4. Add fish to potatoes and simmer until fish flakes, about 5 - 6 minutes
5. Combine milk, cream and butter in a saucepan and heat to scald milk - DO NOT BOIL
6. Slowly pour hot milk mixture into the potato and fish mixture stirring carefully to combine
7. Season with salt and pepper
8. Pour into a soup terrine and garnish with green chopped onion,

## CHOWDER

### CORN CHOWDER

#### INGREDIENTS

- \* 2 Cups Potatoes, diced (500 g)
- \* 1/2 Cup Onion, chopped (125 ml)
- \* 4 Tbsp. Butter (60 ml)
- \* 2 Cups Boiling Water (500 ml)
- \* 3 Cups Creamed Corn (750 ml)
- \* 3 Cups Milk, heated (750 ml)
- \* 1 Tsp. Salt (5 ml)
- \* 1 Tsp. Black Pepper (5 ml)
- \* 1 Tsp. Thyme (5 ml)
- \* 1 Tbsp. Fresh Parsley, chopper (15 ml)

#### DIRECTIONS

1. Peel and dice potatoes. Place in cold water until needed
2. Melt Butter in saucepan.
3. Sauté chopped onion until tender
4. Drain potatoes and toss into onion mixture
5. Add boiling water, salt, pepper and thyme
6. Simmer until potatoes are tender
7. Add corn and milk
8. Simmer for 15 minutes (do not boil)
9. Add chopped parsley and taste to adjust seasoning.
