





Hello everyone. I was asked by the editor of Phalia to tell you a little bit about myself. First, I have been supporting Spearhead Leather Denim Social Club for around 21 + years.

I was a GDI during the various runs that Spearhead had and was the last Mr. Round-Up, at the last Run. I have supported Paint Your Burgers, helped sell raffle tickets, helped set up and tear down various events, supported Fantasy Ball when the club was producing that fun event. I have seen Spearhead Leather Denim Social Club grow and develop, supported various community-based events, seen how they support not just their own leather siblings but other leather groups and non-leather groups both in Toronto and Internationally.

In recent years I have become an Affiliate Member of Spearhead Leather Denim Social Club. This has not changed the way I have supported and will continue to support the work, philanthropy and fun Spearhead does and will continue to do.

I am also a member of The Imperial Court of Toronto (TICOT) where I have served as President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Co-Ball Coordinator, Protocol Minister for the various years/reigns. I have been a TICOT member for around 19 vears.

This year we are expanding our support to help raise funds for our 2-Spirited and Trans Community here in Toronto and Trans Support and Indigenous Community in Belleville Ontario.

TICOT was founded in 1986, The Imperial Court of Toronto (TICOT) is the oldest Ontario chapter of the International Court System (ICS). The ICS is the second largest 2SLGBTQAA+ organization in the world, second only to the Metropolitan Community Church, with 72 chapters across Canada, the USA and Mexico. 20





TICOT is a registered not-for-profit organization that raises funds for 2SLGBTQAA+ charities through donations at a variety of drag performances and social events. TICOT has donated over \$1 million to the community for projects including food banks, woman's shelters, youth programs and HIV programs.

TICOT's Vision is to be a welcoming, inclusive, and innovative social organization with an emphasis on engaging, inspiring, and uniting the local 2SLGBTQA+ community by emphasizing the fun in fundraising. TICOT's Mission: TICOT exists to enhance the social experience of its members and to have a positive impact on the communities we serve through social and fundraising events.

As Emperor 37 along with my co-partner/figure head of TICOT Empress 37 we look Forward to working and supporting the various community organizations within the TICOT Realm.

We are in the process of working with your Vice-President to co-host events. We have had many years of cooperation and supporting each other over the years. However due to pandemic and other reasons we have not been able to do as much as we would have liked together. However, this year we are looking to re-fan those flames and continue with the great work we have been doing over the years.

First off, a Big Thank you goes out to our predecessor Bruce Eves and all the prep work he did to make the transition from a box in our warehouse to the biggest safest box possible. What I mean by that is that his hard work in getting the Board Minutes prepared and ready in 2019 with the City of Toronto Archive, made the delivery and Deed of Gift paperwork portion so easy. From our warehouse to the Archive, the biggest safest box possible . So, Thanks Bruce.

It was a beautiful day, and we went off to the City of Toronto Archives to deliver 3 years of sorting and cataloguing the hardcopies of the Phalia magazines, making sure that we had photocopied all the front covers and documented to the best of our ability the complete collection. Photographs by the thousands and other printed materials were wheeled towards the Archives at 255 Spadina Avenue. Toronto, Ontario on a rickety old dolly from the 80's.

The Archives are massive, with row after row of fire tight boxes stacked up to the roof, this place with its 60 ft ceilings and never-ending rows, seems to go on forever. It's a pretty impressive place. No better than a fire safe and temperature- controlled facility to store 53 years of Phalias and photos and it certainly is not in the 80's but a state-of-the-art facility.

The City of Toronto is now in possession of the 2nd largest collection of Phalias in The World with 242 out of a possible 314 (I say possible as there never was a complete count or correct labelling system, except what we were able to figure out.) The third largest collection has gone to the Leather Archive and Museum in Chicago with 224 issues.

One of our newest members, Derek J., has offered to hand deliver a cross section of the Archives to Berlin at the end of November and FedEx will deliver this collection a selection of 44 Phalias and assorted goodies to the IHLIA in Amsterdam.

A friend Carolyn K. has offered to take the balance of the archives across the pond to London England, where it will be delivered to Bishopgate Special Collections & Archives with 73 issues of Phalia, various Spearhead memorabilia including World Pride pins, "I am Leather" face masks and 50th Anniversary swag. Thanks goes out to Derek J. and Carolyn K. for volunteering to do this and saving us a lot of international courier fees and insurance.

Scott and myself will continue to plug away at the Archives and make sure this fabulous collection is spread around the world in Glorious Spearhead Fashion.





From The Archives, Featured Charter Member: Reprint from Phalia Vol 20 Issue 4 (1999)



Peter Michael Gernon Dec. 2, 1934 - June 5, 1999

Peter Gernon passed away on the morning of June 5, after a lengthy battle with cancer.

Peter was not just a founding member of our affiliation, he was a formidable driving force behind Spearhead's continued success. Loud and outspoken, he backed up his words with action, serving as Director of Publications from 1971-77, and Vice President & Director of Public Relations from 1984-88 and again in 1993. He also served on many committees. Peter was always willing to assist where he could and was often used as a sounding board and a source for advice by members.

Peter had many friends. It was not just the Spearhead circle, but friends he made through 3M, his Co-operative apartment, and other organizations with which he was affiliated. In fact, well over 250 people gathered at Rosar's Funeral Home on June 11 to pay their respects.

As the City Park Co-operative newsletter reported: "Eulogies were read that were poignant, funny, even slightly caustic, as truly befitted a remembrance of Peter. One quote in particular certainly captured the essence of Peter. "Peter is one of those rare individuals who come barging into your life and life is never quite the same after that."

From The Archives, Featured Charter Member: Continued from the previous page.

Peter was the primary moving force "to secure City Park and have it maintained as a safe, secure, co-operative home." There is not one single person living in City Park whose life has not been touched by him, the newsletter stated.

Peter retired a couple of years ago after 34 years at 3M. Those years included time in England and ended as Office Manager of the Sales Branch here in Toronto. 3M's Ross Jarvis remarked on Peter's sensitivity and caring for those he worked with. "He knew their families and always asked after them," Ross said. "The children would surrounded him at the annual company Christmas Party and he called each child by name."

Representing Spearhead, Keith Campbell called Peter "one of a kind." "Everything he did he did with great exuberance. At very rare times he was quiet and appeared to be listening intently...when in actuality he was in another world. This would become evident when he would come out of his trance...and start speaking about something that had no relationship at all to what was being discussed.

"Peter was rarely ever quiet. I recall a Board meeting that was being held at my home several years ago where Peter strongly disagreed with the position some Board Members were taking on a particular issue. The windows were open and his booming voice could be heard for blocks. Due to the sensitivity of the matter...I requested he lower his voice. He got even louder. It was only the threat of having him removed from the meeting that calmed him down.

"Peter could be flamboyant at times. He was often teased about some articles of clothing in his possession and his retort was simply to say 'anyone can dress like you, I'm different."

During his illness, Peter rarely complained. He was determined to beat that horrible disease and made jokes about the side effects of the treatments he had to endure — a sign of a real strength which gained him the respect of all around him.

In his eulogy, City Park's Marv Lucey announced that the co-operative's new Community Hall will be dedicated as a memorial to Peter. In addition, the Hall will become the home of Peter's beloved piano, donated by the family at the suggestion of Jack Mackness, Peter's executor.

No

All of us have gained from knowing Peter and all of us will miss him greatly. He is now without pain and at peace in a better place.

Leather Eats Dinner Group Events (LEDGE) dinners celebrates its one-year anniversary.

LEDGE is a monthly dinner event for gay & queer-identifying folks (and allies) that are into leather, gear and kink/BDSM.



The idea for hosting a leather dinner started in the fall of 2022 when four friends met at Sambuca's on Church to enjoy a pleasant meal and to converse about leather culture. After a few hours of engaging discussions, there was a mutual feeling amongst the foursome that "wouldn't it be nice to do this regularly?" They also wondered if other people might appreciate an event like this. So, two of the friends, Aharon Trottier and Michael Tattersall, coordinated to host their first communal dinner at Sambuca's on Church the following month.

The first official LEDGE dinner took place in November 2022, with 14 attendees. Over the next few months, the event took off: 19 attendees joined in December, and 29 ate together at the January dinner. By February, 40 attendees were present, and the group peaked at over 50 attendees in the Spring.

The dress code is promoted as being "casual leather/gear," with restaurantappropriate rules in effect. This can be as simple as a leather or rubber vest, shirt, pants, or suspenders. If being dressed from head-to-toe in leather is your preference, you are encouraged to do so. There are several BLUF members who attend regularly. All gender expressions are welcome.

The event fosters a sense of community amongst the various queer gear and kinky groups within Toronto. The hosts share that "whether you identify as being part of the Leather culture, or as being Leather-adjacent, or simply just curious... YES, you are welcome to sit at our table. Pull up a chair and chat with the lovely folks who attend. The intention is to have everyone within the community feel welcome."

People who are new and curious about exploring leather, gear or BDSM, find a safe and accessible social venue at these dinners for making new connections. Experienced players in the scene see LEDGE dinners as an opportunity to network with friends and make potential new ones. "Families usually come together around the dinner table. The hope is that LEDGE dinners provides that kind of connection-building opportunities for those seeking a sense of community".

LEDGE dinners are on the first Tuesday of each month, at a restaurant in the Village. The event starts at 6pm and usually finishes around 8:30pm. Many of the attendees then march over to the Black Eagle in gear for the bar's GayStation event. The first Tuesday of each month is GearStation's gear night edition, where folks can socialize and play video games in leather and gear. It's a great venue for LEDGE attendees to continue socializing after dinner, and seeing the Black Eagle full of leather folk is always satisfying. PUMPKIN PIE RECIPE INGREDIENTS:

2 cans of 540mL E.D. Smith Spiced Pumpkin Pie Filling

2 Deep Dish Pie Shells

4 Eggs

¼ cup Cream or Carnation Evaporated Milk

Maple Syrup

Pumpkin Pie Spice (Optional)

8oz package of Cream Cheese

Whip Cream



PUMPKIN PIE RECIPE INSTRUCTIONS:

Preheat the oven to 350F degrees.

Bake the 2 deep dish pie shells for a few minutes to get the moisture out of them.

In a large bow mix the following: 2 cans E.D. Smith Pumpkin Pie Filling add 4 eggs

add ¼ cup of Cream or Carnation Evaporated Milk (NOT Milk).

add some Maple Syrup but not too much.

You may wish to add just a bit of pumpkin pie spice but not too much.

Add an 8oz package of Cream Cheese – really soft first. BUT blend all this well.

Pour into the 2 shells and carefully place on your mid level oven rack and bake for approximately an hour.

Keep an eye on these pies and when your knife comes out clean, you know they are done. COOL first before placing them in the fridge.

Serve cold and with Whip Cream.

I have used this pie recipe for years with great success. Enjoy this recipe.


