

My name is Arthur. I'm thrilled to announce that I've recently been voted in as the new webmaster for the Spearhead Leather Denim Club!


It's an honour to take on this role and contribute to the growth and modernization of our beloved community.

I know too well that those in charge feel comfortable to take on a lot of work and choose to do so because they feel that the work will be done quickly and efficiently. That is the wrong attitude to take. We must see to it that those who offer their help are in fact showing their true colours as SPEARHEAD MEMBERS and because of it they should never be turned down. Nothing is that complicated to do and when someone volunteers, the offer should be accepted.

He told of having two club bar nights, one interclub Sunday bar afternoon, and officers meeting, a general meeting and a club party to attend in one week. Thank god that we are not under that pressure. However, when it is all added up, there are a few people who devote a staggering amount of their time to Spearhead.

At press time we had 73 in-town members. About 25 of those seem to be at every bar night, meeting and function, and are willing to help. There are men who took on the responsibilities of Board or Committee positions and were well aware of the hard job in front of them. To the rest I say, being a member is not quite enough. In wearing the colours, each member makes a commitment to the future of the affiliation. Help, however little is appreciated and will take some of the pressure off the Board and Committee members, and you will be making a positive contribution to the future of Spearhead and to the spirit of brotherhood for which it stands.

Talking of brotherhood, Tribe did it again. Do-A-Fool 82 was in keeping with the long tradition of

Tribe runs - good food, plentiful booze and a great feeling of brotherhood. The men of Tribe put their best efforts into entertainin their brothers and succeeded. On the Sunday evening after the run, Dean and I had dinner with a few of the Tribe guys who were still alive and they were already planning next year's festivities. We owe our thanks to some of our out of town members for their help with our Bar Night at the IC before the run and with our dangerous open bar after the banquet. Due to some "mileage points" from George S. of San Francisco. Spearhead was awarded second place participation as well as an appreciation plaque.

Our Operations Committee has been planning Round-Up for some time. They will need all the help that we can give them, so if you plan on going to the run you can expect to have your name on the duty roster. There are enough of us so that each member need devote only an hour or two to "work."

There seems to be a renewed interest in Spearhead. More people out in colours, more guys at Bar Nights. Now we need your help, both work and input - so keep those cards and letters coming and we will really have an Affiliation of which to be proud.

BROTHERHOOD, A PERSONAL VIEW-

Over the last few months a lot of discussion has gone on concerning the lost brotherhood within Spearhead and I have tried to give the matter some serious thought.

My conclusion is that brotherhood within Spearhead may well be seriously if not terminally ill. I say within Spearhead purposely because I do not think that brotherhood outside of Spearhead is dying. We still feel that same way towards others, witness the Tribe Bar Night and the Trident Weekend. At Round-Up every year brotherhood flows with abandon and some of it rubs off on fellow members as we all have such a wonderful time.

It is so easy to show brotherhood to someone from out of town. Does this mean that we do not have to show brotherhood for people from our own city and worst of all toward our fellow members. Why can't the spirit of Round-Up continue throughout the year. Brotherhood within Spearhead and Toronto must not die for when it does Spearhead dies

We of Spearhead have had a good history of doing things well and I think that at times we have gotten big-headed and think that we are better than

others. Well, in my opinion, the reason that we have been successful in the past is because of brotherhood within Spearhead that permitted us to work together and succeed. The current joke?? (I question calling it a joke because it is too true) "Have you heard about the new Spearhead matches?" "Only twenty of them work!!!"

We are not all working in unison any more. We certainly run enough functions during the year that we could all get involved to make them something special again. The working together helps us to get to know each other, the planning of special events can go on for several months and develops brotherhood outside of the bar scene. Some of our members we only see at the bar or at a function when we are all having a good time and involved in the event. Working together we will get to know each other and you may well discover that you have hidden talents that the affiliation can use to your advantage.

I think that it is time for us all to sit down and ask ourselves the following question "Why did I join Spearhead?". I think that if we all honestly review why we joined Spearhead, what we want from
