State Department To Combat Homophobic Laws

The Administration is planning to launch a worldwide effort to end the criminalization of homosexuality. *U.S. Ambassador to Germany Richard Grenell*, the highest-profile openly gay person in the administration, will reportedly lead the effort, which will be kicked off in Berlin Tuesday, February 19, 2019.

"It is concerning that, in the 21st century, some 70 countries continue to have laws that criminalize LGBTI status or conduct," a U.S. official involved in organizing the event said. When asked about the report at a briefing Tuesday afternoon, State Department spokesman Robert Palladino said Grenell met in Berlin with 11 activists from different countries. "This really is not a big policy departure," Palladino told reporters. "This is longstanding and it's bipartisan."

When asked whether he would describe the meetings as a "new initiative," Palladino replied: "I would say that this is a good opportunity to listen and to discuss ideas about how the United States can advance decriminalization of homosexuality around the world. And that's been our policy."

The U.S. official said that the plan will likely involve collaboration with other countries who have decriminalized homosexuality, the *United Nations*, the *European Union* and the *Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe*. The plan is reportedly aimed at denouncing *Iran* over its human rights record.

Grenell has been a public critic of *Iran*, but has struggled to convince European nations to reimpose sanctions on the Middle Eastern nation following *President Trump's removal of the U.S. from the Obama-era Iran nuclear deal.*

According to a 2017 report from the International Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans and Intersex Association, 72 countries still criminalize homosexuality, including eight where it is punishable by death.

The new campaign will allegedly focus on criminalization, not broader issues such as same-sex marriage.

3 reasons why Trump's plan to decriminalize homosexuality worldwide seems sketchy AF:

The Administration has announced that it will lead a global campaign to decriminalize homosexuality worldwide. That may sound great, but there are reasons to suspect the president's motives. Here's why:

1) Key LGBTQ groups have been left out of the planning.

The Washington Blade pointed out that the campaign's planning meeting in Berlin, didn't invite **OutRight Action International**, the **Human Rights Campaign**, the **Council for Global Equality, the Lesbian and Gay Federation of Germany (the country's largest non-governmental LGBT rights group)** or the **International Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Trans and Intersex Association-Europe** to the table.

If you're really trying to get rid of homophobic laws internationally, why would you exclude some of the world's leading experts in international homophobia?

2) Trump has repeatedly turned away refugees seeking asylum from anti-LGBTQ countries.

Remember *Chechnya*, the *Russian region* that has been kidnapping, detaining torturing and killing queer people for about two years now? Yeah, *the U.S. hasn't issued visas to any Chechans feeling violence there. The U.S. also recently sent a trans woman fleeing violence in El Salvador back to her home country—she was promptly murdered upon*

returning.

Lots of *South and Central American* countries have widespread *anti-LGBTQ violence*, but *Trump has characterized any immigrants fleeing there as rapists and criminals*. So why the sudden change of heart? *If he's serious about this, let's see some asylum visas.*

3) Trump has used anti-LGBTQ politics to push for racist policies in the past.

During the 2016 U.S. presidential campaign, Trump said, "*I will do everything in my power to protect our LGBTQ citizens from the violence and oppression of the hateful, foreign ideology, believe me.*" He said this immediately after the *Pulse nightclub shooting*, and the statement suggested that he'd oppose queerphobia Muslim-majority countries while ignoring anti-LGBTQ sentiment at home.

This is a ideology known as "homonationalism," a term defined as:

Whenever a person or group claims solidarity with the LGBTQ community as a way to justify racist and xenophobic policies, especially ones against people of color, immigrants, Muslims or other countries. *Homonationalism* often takes the view that other people, cultures or countries are inherently homophobic and that Western countries are more culturally, morally, and politically advanced and egalitarian *(that is, they believe that all people deserve equal rights and opportunities).*

Several outlets have noted that the new campaign seems mostly to be a way to shame any country still doing business with Iran. Considering that the campaign will mostly focus on the Middle East, African or the Caribbean (and likely won't touch Russia) it seems a bit too geo-targeted to not have an ulterior motive behind it.

Russian LGBTI activist at risk after reporting torture in Chechnya

Pro-government groups threatened activist Igor Kochetkov after he reported the alleged torture of LGBTI people in Chechnya

Russia must protect activists and journalists who report crimes against LGBTI people, *Human Rights Watch warned* on Friday, February 15th. Leading *Russian LGBT Network activist, Igor Kochetkov*, has faced intimidation after reporting the latest *anti-gay purge in Chechnya*.

Authorities have arrested more than 40 people on suspicion of being LGBTI since December 2018, according to the UN. Two people have also reportedly died from torture.

At the end of January, *Kochetkov* filed a complaint with *Russia's Investigation Agency*. He then gave the names of *14 people that authorities unlawfully detained and tortured in Chechnya's capital, Grozny*.

He also reported the name of one man who police allegedly killed in January.

After the complaint, however, the leader of a pro-government group in *Chechnya uploaded a YouTube video threatening Kochetkov.*

Ali Baskhanov called Kochetkov a 'son of the devil' and warned that if he came to Chechnya it would be his 'final stop', according to HRW.

Kochetkov says authorities did not take his complaints of the threat seriously. He is now planning to sue the Investigative Department.

'The threats against Igor Kochetkov are very serious and deserve a prompt reaction by the Russian authorities, 'said HRW.

A spokesperson for Chechnya's government last month said: 'This is an absolute lie, there is not a single grain of truth and it is completely baseless'. *"There were no detentions on grounds of sexual orien tation in the indicated periods in the Chechen Republic"*. But then again according to the President of the Chechen Republic, *"There are no LGBTQ people in Chechnya, they do not exist!"*

Without a doubt, these are the most well known words in the history of the United States-our solemn creed written so prominently on our national upon individual freedoms by many of the founding fathers when the Constitution was being constructed. That Constitution would have never come to pass without the promise of the **Bill of Rights** to further ensure that nobody can stand in the way of our pursuit of happiness, so long as our efforts don't harm others or interfere with their rights. Yet, even with those safeguards in place, we've still managed to butcher the whole thing more often than not. How can that be? As I see it, the culprit is the use of faith as a weapon.

Faith, like most everything else, comes down to individual perception. No two people share an identical set of faith-based beliefs. Sure, we find others who are similarly inclined and give our groups names, but within those groups of people, there are no two individuals who have identical beliefs, understandings, interpretations, or convictions. So sects form within our groups. Then, as sects, we go around claiming the moral high ground and demanding conformity. The Pilgrims left England because they refused to conform to the church there. Then as soon as they got on their feet in America, they started demanding everyone conform to their way here, gious minions to do his bidding and weaponize their faith. thus people were ostracized and sects formed and split. Consequently, new colonies formed. Our very map reflects the truth in what I write. And not much has changed.

We have a dark history of using faith to justify atrocities and denving rights to people who don't conform to our faith-based sect's norms. We killed or drove out millions of *Native Americans* because they were "godless savages" who would not conform. We enslaved millions of Afri*cans* and justified it because we made them conform to *Christianity*. We strong-armed Mexico into giving up nearly half their country in the name of Manifest Destiny-the hysteria-driven notion that God wanted America to spread from coast to coast. The Civil War finally brought an end to slavery and the 13th. 14th. and 15th Amendments auaranteed equal rights to those freed blacks. But men and women in the South, under the guise of their Christian faith, put on white robes and hoods and began years of terrorism to keep the newly enfranchised blacks from their pursuit of happiness. But hate, fear, and bigotry know no borders and soon. what began in the South had infested the entire nation.

Faith, weaponized, in the name of nationalism-does this sound familiar?

As America continued to diversify and the non-conformers began to fight for real equality, using faith as a weapon went out of fashion-at least out in the open for all to see-and lost its social acceptability. Between the 1950s and the 2000s, America appeared to have made great strides toward finally beginning to live up to our creed. Many of the most hateful bigots climbed back under their rocks as more people than ever seemed to be free to pursue happiness without someone bludgeoning them with their faith. We saw women's rights take many steps forward. We saw the Civil **Rights Movement** bring black Americans far up the social ladder. **Thur-**

Faith and the Pursuit of Happiness good Marshall became a Supreme Court Justice, Jackie Robinson broke baseball's color barrier, soon opening the doors for black athletes to compete in all sports. Black actors and actresses began to find real roles in movies. Big steps forward in the high profile limelight, which served as a beacon of hope for others, but much work remained for the vast majority birth certificate. Yes, we hold these words dear. We also have abused them of minorities. Later, LGBTQ people began to score major victories in from the very beginning and have never even come close to living up to *their pursuit of happiness*, even winning the right to marry (at least in them. The Declaration of Independence is a lofty target at which we have some places). To cap it all off, we got to witness one of the most iconic been aiming for more than 240 years. Yet, that target sits in nearly pristine *moments in all of US history, the inauguration of Barack Obama, the* condition as we've missed the mark time and time again. Because of the *first black president*, who went on to preside over 8 years of tremendous egalitarian message of Jefferson's words, there was a premium placed economic growth, bringing the nation from the brink of financial ruin back to prosperity.

But all the while, beneath the surface, bubbled a cauldron of stagnant hate and bigotry. It began to slowly resurface through the conservative vents of talk radio, Fox News, and social media. This vitriolic magma began to force its way up to the surface and became the lava of misinformation and mendacious propaganda. That lava became a weapon and faith was at its core. Hateful whispers about the "Muslim from Kenya" turned to shouts. One of the leading shouters was none other than **Donald Trump**, who began to hint that he was going to throw his hat into the ring for a presidential run in 2016. Everyone laughed back then, but no one is laughing now.

Trump masterfully agined a stranglehold on the religious right although a thorough and meticulous review of his history would turn up not one iota of evidence that he had ever been a man of faith. Yet, inexplicably, his largest support base became white, rural, conservative Christians. The remarkably unfair Electoral College process did the rest and, despite losing the popular vote by 3 million, Trump convinced his reli-

Today, our president honors the man whom Native Americans consider the American Hitler, Andrew Jackson, by hanging his portrait in the Oval Office. Today, we vilify African Americans for peacefully demonstrating during the *National Anthem* in order to shed light on the injustices they see and live with every day-conform or get out, they are told. Today, we attempt to wall out our neighbors to the south when they try to seek *refuge in the lands that we took from them.* We separate the children from their parents destroying families because, after all. God wanted us to have that land and those people will try to destroy everything we've built. Today, people use their faith in an attempt to deny LGBTO couples of even the most basic of services and demand their loving marriages to be nullified and that they be barred from pursuing the happiness of raising children.

Faith is once again being weaponized in an effort to blast away at rights gained through more than a century of sacrifice under the cover of MAGA hats and the slogan of "America First".

When we see people of faith lauding the president for trying to "make America great again", it doesn't take a genius to figure out what they are really saying. The "good old days", for them, harkens back to a time when using faith as a weapon was widely accepted and gained them status at the expense of millions who didn't conform to their norms.

Using faith as a weapon serves only to deny others their right to pursue happiness.



Barr rejects the separation of church and state, calls secularists "fanatics," and blames secularism for supposed "moral decline."

As the nation lurches closer towards being ruled by a tyrannical dictator with unwavering support from the Republican Party, the American people are ignoring an even greater threat to their waning secular democracy - rule by tyrannical theocrats.

The rise of *theocrats* in powerful positions of authority is particularly disconcerting because not only was America created as a secular nation *with a secular Constitution*, but because the theocrats running the federal government represent a very small minority of the population. And now Trump has given that vicious minority what they elected him to do in the first place; another radical Christian extremist, William Barr, in a powerful federal government position.

J. Beauregard Sessions was a legitimate threat to America's secular government as Trump's attorney general, but his theocratic aspirations paled in comparison to Trump's latest theocratic cabinet member - a conservative Catholic malcontent who is unlikely to ever defend the **U.S. Constitution because it is a secular document.** It is noteworthy that Sessions only stated that, according to his mind, the 'separation of church and state' in the Constitution is a concept that is unconstitutional. However, his replacement ardently believes that America's government is duty-bound to enforce god's laws because there is no place for secularism.

In a 1995 essay, **Barr** expressed the extremist Christian view that "American government should not be secular;" secularism is an abomination in Barr's theocratic mind despite the law of the land is unmistakably secular. Furthermore, Barr contends America's government is supposed to be imposing "a transcendent moral order with objective standards of right and wrong that flows from God's eternal law;" eternal law best dictated by the Vatican and taught in public schools at taxpayer's expense.

It is true that as attorney general William Barr will defend Trump's criminality and corruption; it is one of the only reasons Trump nominated him. However, the real danger to the nation is Barr's belief that the government's primary function should be defending and enforcing his god's moral edicts while ardently opposing any legislative branch effort to make secular laws according to the secular Constitution.

As noted by Michael Stone a couple of weeks ago, in addition to the racism *ernment assault on women*. and misogyny one expects from a radical conservative Christian, "Barr is For an idea of how an avowed anti-choice theocrat leading the Justice Dealso a bigot when it comes to non-religious people and others who respect the separation of church and state."

Barr epitomizes the typical extremist religious fanatic by blaming everyalleges is "the federal government's non-stop attacks on traditional "artificial" birth control. Don't believe it?

In an address to "The Governor's Conference on Juvenile Crime, Drugs There is no good outcome going forward with an avowed theocrat serving

and Gangs," Barr condemned the idea of adhering to the U.S. Constitution's mandated separation of church and state in the public education system. The theocrat said: "This moral lobotomy of public schools has been based on extremist notions of separation of church and state or on theories of moral relativism which reject the notion that there are standards of rights or wrong to which the community can demand adherence."

Barr also penned an article in *The Catholic Lawyer* where he complained vehemently about what he asserted was "the rise of secularism;" something he claims is anathema to a nation he believes should be ruled by theocrats. Barr attempted to give an answer to "the challenge of representing Catholic institutions as authorities" on what is considered right and wrong, or morally acceptable in a secular nation. In discussing what Barr termed was "The Breakdown of Traditional Morality," the new attorney general complained thus: "We live in an increasingly militant, secular age... As part of this philosophy, we see a growing hostility toward reliaion, particularly Catholicism. This form of bigotry has always been fashionable in the United States. There are, today, even greater efforts to marginalize or 'ghettoize' orthodox religion...'

Barr is also a bigot when it comes to people who respect the Constitution's separation of church and state in providing equal rights for all Americans whether theocrats agree or not. Barr's belief that government is bound to enforce Vatican dictates is what drives his assertion that, for example, equal rights laws demanding that colleges treat homosexual groups like any other student group is inherently wrong.

He claims treating LGBTQ people like everyone else is detrimental because: "[Equality] dissolves any form of moral consensus in society. There can be no consensus based on moral views in the country, only enforced neutrality."

It is noteworthy that what Barr considers "enforced neutrality" is what most Americans understand is the U.S. Constitution's guarantee of equal rights for all Americans. If this country was not plagued with religious extremists, bigots, misogynists, and hate-driven conservatives there would never be a need to "enforce neutrality," or protect all Americans' equal rights guaranteed according to secular law. There is no such thing as equality in Barr's theocratic mind and the idea of the government not enforcing the privilege and superiority the religious right has enjoyed for too long is abominable, and now he wields federal government authority to right that abomination.

It is too bad that Barr's religious mind incites him to believe the federal government's job is enforcing his religion's concept of "morality," and that the purposely-conceived "secular" law of the land is "militant" and "hostile toward religion, particularly Catholicism." If any American believes Barr will defend the Constitution, or equal rights, or freedom from religious imposition, they are deluded beyond belief. As the religious right's attorney general, Barr will be the de facto enforcement arm of the evangelical extremists and aid in implementing all of the horrors a theocratic dictatorship entails – beginning with an increased gov-

Appellate Court Ruling 6th District

Cincinnati OH, Tuesday March 12, 2019 - The full Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals upheld a law that will drastically restrict access to critical health care and education in Ohio.

This is a devastating blow for people across Ohio. This 2016 law signed by *Governor John Kasich* stripped funding that helps Planned Parenthood provide 70,000 free STD and HIV tests, cancer screenings, domestic violence education through the Violence Against Women Act, and *Planned Parenthood's Healthy Moms, Healthy Babies* program that works to reduce Ohio's alarming infant mortality rate, especially among African American babies.

Last year, a three-judge panel for the Sixth Circuit unanimously ruled this law unconstitutional. Then Ohio Attorney General Mike DeWine, unhappy with the outcome, appealed and asked for a full court hearing. **This is** part of a nearly decade long of attacks on reproductive health care and education from Ohio politicians like Mike DeWine.

Yesterday's ruling found it constitutional to block the most at-risk communities in our state from accessing lifesaving health care and education. People facing discrimination, including, LGBTQ people people of color, people with disabilities, people with low incomes, and women will be the ones to bear the brunt of this law. This is a giant step backwards for Ohio.

This comes as state legislators continue to push a number of anti-abortion

as the nation's top law enforcement official. This is particularly true since bills, including the six-week abortion ban, which would outlaw abortion Barr has made no secret that he considers the secular government before most people know they're pregnant. You know Equality Ohio as the champions for LGBTQ equality in policy and law. I'm proud to share that we're growing a bit and adding something new to the work we do every day across the state.

We've been hearing more and more stories from *LGBTQ Ohioans* who need legal help, so we are doing something about it-we're launching the Equality Ohio Legal Clinic.

Over the last several months, we've travelled the state and asked *LGBTO* **Ohioans:** if **Equality Ohio** were to offer legal services, how should we do it? What would make you feel like it was made for you?

We heard it needed to be cheap. So we made it free.

We heard it needed to be easy to access. So we put our intake online and setup an easy phone number at 855-LGBT-LAW.

We heard it needed to be informed by the needs of *LGBTQ* people. So we hired attorneys who are champions for LGBTQ equality.

Equality Ohio's Legal Clinic offers many legal services, such as consumer law (fraud and identity theft), family law, civil rights, administrative help (like SSI or disability) and more. This free service is available to people who are within 300% of the federal poverty line. We will also seek to refer folks we cannot represent directly to a culturally humble attorney who can help.

Equality Ohio's Legal Clinic would not be possible without funding from the Ohio State Bar Foundation, the Cleveland Foundation, and a Victims of Crime Advocacy grant through the Ohio Attorney General's office. Thank you!

GRACE NOTES FROM ALL OVER....New York's Metropolitan Opera has had several highlights this season, including two pairings of Russian superstar Anna Netrebko with last season's most talked about Met debutante, the Georgian mezzo Anita Rachvelishvili. They opened this season together in Verdi's "Aida", both earning a virtual firestorm of critical and popular acclaim. Recently they refueled their little frenzy in sell-out performances of Cilea's warhorse for two divas, "Adriana Lecouvrer," a story, based on historic fact, set in eighteenth-century Paris about is a princess poisoning her romantic rival, a celebrated actress, over the love of a social climbing Speaking hotties, which is a good thing, Texan Beto O'Rourke, or Beta Carnot-so-hottie. These two ladies hung new flesh on the opera's old bones and really ignited the stage. One critic remarked, we needn't mourn the passing of the so-called Golden Age of Opera. It's going on right now!

Popping off to New York for the Metropolitan Opera is probably a stretch for most of us, even the most fanatic opera queen, but for several Saturdays during the season, one can attend a live performance transmitted via satellite to cinemas locally and in more than seventy countries around the world. (Taped performances are repeated the following Wednesday evenings.) They present the live performance as a more cinematic rather than proscenium experience with perfect sightlines, close-ups, the subtitles in the national language where shown, and vivid HD projection and sound. While not exactly cheap admission, they are a great savings over a special trip. A full schedule of these satellite airings and the cinemas where they are shown can be seen on the web at <a>www.metopera.org>. Right now I know that locally, they can be seen at Valleyview (Yes Virginia, there's multiplex virtually hidden behind Quaker Steak and Lube.), the Cedar Lee, and Richmond Mall.

Very occasionally, PBS presents one of these performances, taped from the new modern opera called "Marnie", composed by Nico Muhly with libretto by Nicholas Wright, from a novel by Winston Graham. Now, it all that's not too daunting, "Marnie" was also a flop movie directed by Alfred Hitchcock quite a few years back. This opera is going to be a revelation to people who don't like modern opera: no weird political slants (We're saturated with those anyhow!), no atonal or rap music, no electronic special effects, just great singing, a fascinating mystery story, rapid-fire staging, and a beautiful American singer in the title role. Her name is Isabel Leonard and she's hot! The mystery is about why Marnie is a compulsive thief, changing identities, looks, and robbing each new employer of thousands in cash and stolen property. The clothes she wears are countless and gorgeous. Between acts, in addition to the eye candy of watching squadrons of hunky stage hands erect, build, and, really putting their backs into it, shoving and

> CLOSER TO HOME on the musical front, the amazing Joyce DiDonato, of the Metropolitan Opera and just about anywhere else in the world where she wants to descend from musical heaven, recently put on a little gettogether in Oberlin's Finney Chapel. In her touring show entitled "Songplay", the statuesque blonde mezzo-soprano, backed-up by five classical musicians, using what she described as a beginning singing student's time-honored bete-noir, a dog-eared, yellowed book of Italian art songs, demonstrated the foundations for musical relationships, such as that of baroque song with modern jazz. Since Oberlin boasts one of the country's preeminent musical conservatories, half the sell-out crowd were students. They treated her like a rock star.
